LETTING-OUT-CATTLE-COMPETITION AND

EASTER SPRINT (WRE) / CITY RACE 2017

8th of APRIL 2017. TSIATSUNGÕLMAA, Juba village, Võru parish, Võru county, ESTONIA 9th of APRIL 2017. VÕRU TOWN, Võru county, ESTONIA ORGANIZER: OK VÕRU

PROGRAMME:

8th of April Letting-out-cattle-competition (long distance), starts from 13.00,

MN21A (M = men, N = Women) start at 13.30.

9th of April Easter sprint MW21E, starts from 11:00, rest of the classes start after the elite WRE

competition, roughly around 12:30. All non-elite classes have longer courses than traditional

sprint (so called *city race* format).

CLASSES:

MN8NR; MN10NR; MN12; MN14; MN16; MN18; MN21A (only the 1st day); MW21E (only the 2nd day); MN21B; MN35, MN40; MN45; MN50; MN55; MN60; MN65; MN70

The organizer has the right to merge classes if not more than 4 participants have entered in that class by the entry deadline.

Open courses ca 3 and 6 km (08.04); ca 2 and 4 km (09.04) entries are made on the spot.

TERRAIN AND MAP:

1st DAY Tsiatsungõlmaa, military training area. A forest that is rather poor with landforms, but contains marshes of various sizes, some medium-detailed contour areas and plenty of army-origin pits. Mainly coniferous forest with runnability from good to very good. Height differences up to 15 meters. There is a dense network of forest roads, paths and rides over the area. Area new to orienteering, map authors Madis Oras and Timo Sild, winter 2017.

2nd DAY The competition terrain is a part of Võru town centre. The town has a regular street network, but the blocks are rather strongly complicated by fences and gates/passages. The height differences in the terrain are virtually non-existent. A large part of the area is new to orienteering, map authors Lauri Sild, Timo Sild and Markus Puusepp, 2017.

PRELIMINARY COURSE LENGTHS

1st day

M21A 15-16 km, N21A 11-12 km, classes MN8-12 expected winning times 10-20 min, in the rest of the classes planned winning times range between 30-60 min.

2nd day: expected winning times:

MN21E 12-15 min, MN8-12 10-20 min, rest of the classes between 20-35 min.

STARTING FORMATS:

Both days interval start. Only exception being MN21A on the 1st day, where a mass start will be held.



COMPETITION CENTRE AND GETTING THERE:

Route signs to 1st day (8th of April) to the competition centre starts from Võru-Mõniste-Valga highway, about 6 km from Võru town.

On the 2nd day (9th of April) MW21E classes have a pre-start quarantine at Kreutzwaldi 16, Võru. Rest of the classes gather at the competition centre at Liiva 13, Võru (back-garden of Võru culture house "Kannel")



CONTROL PUNCHING SYSTEM:

SPORTident punching system in all classes. Own SI-card numbers have to be provided through entries. Rental cards are available for $1 \in /$ day.

SHOWERS:

Warm out-door shower on the 1^{st} day (if the natural water resources allow it). On the 2^{nd} day there is an indoor shower for MW21E, other classes have a possibility to shower at Võru Sports Centre for a fee of $1 \le 700$ meters from the competition centre.


CATERING:
