Welcome

Koovee welcomes you to Tampere!

Koovee is a sports club having several divisions, some of them just for enjoying sports as a hobby, some of them having goals on the top of the nation or even of the world. The latter ones include e.g. orienteering, floorball, figure skating, wrestling and pétanque. This year the club has the honour to host two junior competitions on world championship level, an orienteering competition in July, and a wrestling competition in August.

Tampere is the optimal place for orienteering in Finland. We have several orienteering clubs to keep even the local level of competitions high, terrains so versatile that once you learn to orienteer here, you can orienteer anywhere, and almost all main orienteering competitions of Finland closer than 200 kilometres from here. In 2001, we hosted together with Tampereen Pyrintö the first world championship ever on sprint orienteering, and ever since we have gained more and more expertise on sprint competitions in addition to the more traditional types of foot orienteering.

This year we will bring the competitors to the forests of Teisko and to the center of the city. They will learn the beauty of the rural country and the stairs of Pispala. In July, the weather is the warmest in Finland, but may vary a lot from chilly to hot (from 15 to over 30 degrees). Even if we can't promise much about the weather, we can promise you a warm welcome to Tampere.

Competition Rules

The Competition Rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events (version from 1st January 2017) shall be applied for participation in the Junior World Orienteering Championships2017. Please refer to the Competition Rules on the IOF website www.orienteering.org

Maps are following ISOM 2000 (Middle, long and relay) and ISSOM 2007 (Sprint).

Rule deviation for JWOC 2017 in Tampere:

The olive green areas (symbol no 527) on ISOM maps are forbidden areas.

Classes and Participation Restricitions

Classes: W 20, M 20

All competitors must be born in or after 1997 and must be full passport-holding citizens of the country they are representing.

Anti-Doping Code

Doping is strictly forbidden and the organizers of the JWOC 2017 are dedicated to supporting the anti-doping authorities in their work.

Doping tests are always carried out in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard for Testing. The IOF Anti-Doping Code and rules and the World Anti-Doping Code 2015 apply as of 1st January 2015.

Athletes who are selected for the doping tests must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also bring along their Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, it is advisable that the athletes bring along their ID to all the competitions and events.

Punching and Time-Keeping system

Emit punching systems will be used in all competitions. New Emit cards and EmiTags will be given for competitors. Timing (end results) will be done using EmiTags. The punching in sprint will be done by the Emit touchfree system with the EmiTag, in all other events with the Emit card by manual punching. The punching with both systems will be shown at the technical model event on Sunday.

Health services (First aid)

First-aid services will be provided at the competitions. Each federation is responsible for its own insurance (as per Rule #6.4).

Online production

There will be GPS-tracking, online internet results, video-feed in internet and a live speaker at all events.

Clothing

The clothing rules of the Finnish Orienteering Federation apply which means that dress is free in all disciplines.

It is forbidden to use shoes with metal spikes in any competitions and trainings. Metal studs are allowed in the Long, Middle and Relay races, but not in the Sprint race.

Weather/Climate

The summers in Tampere are mild. In July, the daily mean temperature is 16.9°C, with the average low temperature being 11.7 °C. The average high temperature is 22.2 °C. Average precipitation is 75 mm, with an average of 15 rainy days.

Event center

The Athletes' Village for JWOC will be in the Murikanranta. Conference Hotel Murikanranta is a unique restaurant, meeting and accommodation center surrounded by beautiful nature in Teisko, Tampere. Murikanranta together with the unique environment will create a real athletes' village with a great atmosphere for JWOC 2017. Murikanranta will offer the athletes accommodation, food, different free time activities and a peaceful environment for concentrating on the competitions. The hotel has great facilities for team and team leader meetings as well as for different events such as the JWOC Party on Saturday 15.7.

Murikanranta has been under renovation for some time, and there will still be some renovation taking place during the JWOC competition week. However, this should not interfere with the activities of the athletes in Murikanranta.

Venue and access

With a population of well over 200,000, Tampere (founded in 1779) is the largest inland city in the Nordic countries.

Thanks to the new city planning, former industrial areas such as Finlayson and Tampella are alive again: cafes, restaurants, shops, cinemas, museums and galleries have found a place there.

There is a lot to see in Tampere: original Finnish architecture, breath-taking lake sceneries, magnificent glacial ridges, beautiful parks and lush forests next to the city center. Tampere is located in southern Finland some 170 km north of Helsinki, the capital of the country. It is within easy reach: less than two hours by train or by car from the both major coastal cities (Helsinki & Turku) and even more conveniently accessible by air, thanks to good flight connections. The distance from the Tampere-Pirkkala airport to the center of Tampere is about 17 km. The railway station is situated in the city center.

Embargoed areas

Competitors, team officials, and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competitions, are not allowed to enter the embargoed area, except on the designated routes

shown on the embargo maps and with no map of the terrain.

Other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competitions are for example, but not exclusively, intermediate family members, club coaches or managers or coaches working for federation. If for any reason, permission for access into embargoed terrain is needed, it shall be requested from the organizer (Rule 14.4).

Team officials' meetings

For each competition, a team officials' meeting will be held before the competition day, providing all important information about the competitions.

There will only be one meeting for both the Long Distance and Relay.

All team officials' meetings will be held in the event center in Murikanranta.

Training

Trainings around Tampere are available.



The sprint course lengths are the shortest feasible route as specified in IOF Foot Orienteering Competition Rules.

Wednesday. Own transports are allowed for coaches / team members going directly to the competition center with their own cars.

With the extra cost of 20 euros you can sign for the transportations to model events. The transport package should be bought in advance from the online store (http://www.jwoc2017.fi/product-category/services)

The public busses (lines 90, 90M and 90Mx) drive between Maisansalo or Maisansalo crossroad and Tampere City centre approximately once an hour on weekdays. You can see the timetables here http://aikataulut.tampere.fi/?lang=en&line=90.

For spectators

Bus transportation is arranged between Tampere City centre (Hakametsä ice hockey hall) and competition centres. Signing up and payment can be made by 26th June using a form that can be found on the competition website 2017.fin5.fi. The ticket prices for adults are 30 €/ week or 10 €/day or children under 12 years 24 €/week or 8 €/day.

Tickets for the buses are sold also at the information points in the competition centres and the starting places of the buses, if there is space left. (those who have bought their tickets in advance are a priority.) The prices are 12 €/day or 8 €/direction for adults and children under 12 years 10 €/day or 6 €/direction.

Accommodation

The main place for accommodation during JWOC 2017 is the Conference Hotel Murikanranta. The different possibilities, rates and the board that they include are presented in the table below.

The accommodation package consists of 7 nights from Sunday 9th to Sunday 16th. An extra night June 8th-9th can be ordered separately by email jwoc2017@gmail. com. The prices follow the total package prices in the chosen category.

All accommodation should be booked no later than 9 May 2017, and the payment should be done on 21 May 2017 at the latest. The booking of accommodation is done through the IOF Eventor at https://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/5109. First come, first serve!

Of course, you may also book accommodations not listed by the organizers. However, make sure they are not located within the embargoed areas! Official (and compulsory) transports to the competitions starts only from Murikanranta

Also those who have ordered category D packages are able to order dinners or evening snacks with extra payment. Kitchen facilities for those who will make their own evening meals are located in Maisakki cottage village, 0,5 km from Murikanranta.

It is possible to also order lunches in Murikanranta on Sunday 9th or Thursday 13th and dinner on Saturday 8v or Sunday 9th. Binding orders for all the extra meals should be made by email jwoc2017@gmail.com by the end of May. More information in the services and accommodation table below.

In competition arenas

In each competition arena, lunch will be served. JWOC participants are entitled to order a lunch package for the whole week for the cost of 25 euros (incl. lunches on five competition days). Meals

The teams who have reserved the full board package (category A, B or C) will be served the meals from Monday 10th breakfast to Sunday 16th breakfast (breakfasts, dinners and evening snacks). Category D accommodation includes breakfast, but no other meals.

Accreditation

All registered participants must check in for accreditation at the JWOC Event Center on Saturday, 8 July 2017 or Sunday morning, 9 July 2017 before 12:00. Each registered team member must be present and show her/his personal passport before she/he can be accredited. A personal JWOC ID card with photo will be handed out at accreditation. All accredited persons must wear it at all relevant times and present it for

access to all means of transport and authorized zones. The online entry form asks that all persons to be accredited provide a personal portrait photo in Eventor for use on the ID card.

Some practical information for the teams

- Murikanranta is only meant for team members and authorized organisers.
- Guests can meet athletes in the common area and they need to register in the reception.
- Orienteering shoes or other shoes with spikes are not to be worn indoors.
- The Murikanranta beach sauna can be reserved for a separate payment. The saunas directly by the accommodation are free for all.
- · Murikanranta offers free wifi.
- There is a small kiosk at Murikanranta, but the closest grocery shop is 7 km away. The closest bus stop is 2 km away.

Spectators and FIN5 Orienteering Week

JWOC 2017 will be hosted simultaneously with the Fin5 Orienteering week.

The Fin5 Orienteering Week is the most popular orienteering event in Finland. It has been organized since 1984. The Fin5 Orienteering Week is an official event of the Finnish Orienteering Federation.
