30.09.–01.10. 2017 Mägede village, Albu municipality, district Järvamaa.

COMPETITION CLASSES

E – Elite course, A – Technical course, B – Easy course, C – Beginners course (very easy), NR – String course, TR – Partially stringed course, M – Men, N – Women.

Open courses (no pre-registration, enrollment at the Secretariat):

O3 (short and easy),

O6 (long and technical).

The organiser retains the right to incorporate classes if there is less than four participants enrolled in one age class by the deadline of pre-registration.

Attendance is at your own risk.

TERRAIN AND MAP

Terrain varies– there are hilly areas with lots of knolls, depressions and marshes of different sizes, there are marsh areas with different sizes of firm grounds and flatter areas with smaller land forms. Greatest height difference on the slope is 40 metres. There are areas with dense network of skiing and biking tracks. Forest coverage is 90%, predominantly coniferous, with variable ease of passage.

Map scale 1:10 000, h=5 m. Fieldwork was done in Autumn 2016 and in Spring 2017.

The map corresponds to ISOM 2017 requirements set by IOF.

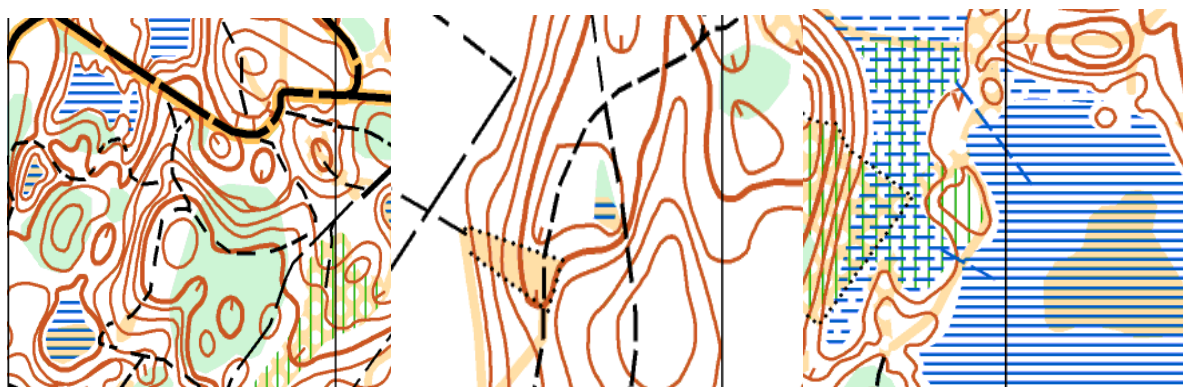

PUNCHING SYSTEM

SPORTident is used. SI-chips can be rented from the organizer for a fee of 1,5 € per day. Rental fee must be paid upon registration together with the entry fee. Fee for a lost or broken SI-card is up to 60 €.
