

START PROCEDURE


- follow maps,




Passage not for ATHLETES

QUESTIONS

Q: Can team athletic trainer signs in to the quarantine zone and enter the team zone? (TPE)

A: Way from Quarantine to Area will be explained by Quarantine crew,

Q: In model there were quite many fences/gates closed which should've been open and vice versa. Will the organizer secure that this will not be the case in the competition? (FIN)

A: Controversial gates will be guarded, but there is only two of them. This issue shouldn't influence sport competition



Q: There were at least two chains dangerously high and not marked on the map (around the parking area; near control no 34). Will it be like that in the competition area? (FIN)

A: It shouldn't be issue during competition, however all dangerously high chains will be marked in terrain with tape.

Q: A part of the control numbers covered essential subjects (e.g. no 34 & 35). Will it be like that in competition maps? (FIN)

A: It will be enhanced on competition maps.

Q: Will organizers use whistles to prevent pedestrian incidents? (AUT) A: No.



Q: When competition time starts counting for runner? (DEN)

A: Runners must start when starting referee raise hand from shoulder on starting line. Then athletes must go and use start gate, then time starts counting.

Q: Which loop will be up which down? (SWE)

A: Organizers can not give answer for this question, course starts with control number 1.

Q: Since there is no coaching zone, can coaches coaching during arena passage? (DEN)

A: Yes during arena passage, but they can't give informations to runner during starting procedure.



Q: What about traffic and tram during competition? (GBR)

A: During competition traffic will be closed, however there could be some cars driving out from closed area. Tram will not go.

Q: Will be there confusing junction for runners in area during passage?(CZE)

A: No.

Q: When runners can leave area? (SUI)

A: When last runner cross finish line, however we strongly encourage all Teams to take part in Opening Ceremony and Medal Ceremony.

Q: What about lunch on Wednesday? (SUI)

A: Lunch will be served in official Catering Center.
