


4. General informations about WCF 2017

- There are quite many barbed wire fences (mapped) and mobile fences (not mapped) in the forest terrains. Please be careful while crossing them and report damages at the finish. Some are marked with yellow tape to be more visible.
- There can also be cattle on the pasture, they are used to tourists, so it will not be a problem.
- Respect out-of-bound areas marked on the map.
- Those marked with a line on the map, are marked with red-white tape in the terrain. It's the same for all competitions (long, middle and sprint).




Arena passage: take the right corridor, the left corridor leads to the finish (you may see it out of the cable car when going to the quarantine ;-))


