Participants of classes H21E and D21E must also register through Eventor ([eventor.orienteering.org](http://eventor.orienteering.org)), so they will make two entries, one in the normal CBO system and the other in the Eventor. The second one for IOF control. Elite athletes participating in the WRE must include their IOF identification numbers (IOF ID) in their entries in the Eventor (ID is not required in SISCBO). Athletes who do not have prior classification must request an IOF ID before their registration for a World Ranking Event (WRE). To do this, you must access Eventor at: <http://eventor.orienteering.org/Events>. After login, click on "create a new account" and follow the steps (in English).

**Note: For athletes of classes M/W21E, registration in the Eventor is a mandatory condition for participation in the event.**

## *History of Santa Maria City*

The first known inhabitants of the region currently occupied by Santa Maria city were the Minuti Indians and Tapes. The city was created from camps of a demarcation commission of the boundaries between lands of Spanish and Portuguese dominion that were in the region. The commission set up the camps, where the Saldanha Marinho Square is located in 1797. During the Farroupilha Revolution (1835-1845), the first German immigrants from São Leopoldo arrived, seeking to get out of the fighting.

The city preserves historic buildings of great value, such as the Cathedral of Nossa Senhora da Conceição, Treze de Maio Theatre, the Cathedral of the Mediator of the Episcopal Anglican Church of Brazil, the Caixeiral Club of Santa Maria, the National Bank of Commerce, Union Society of The Travellers' Clerks and the Belgian Village. Santa Maria hosts one of the largest public universities in Brazil, the Federal University of Santa Maria. The university currently has almost 27,000 students in its undergraduate and postgraduate courses.

By having a large amount of educational institutions, the city is known as "City-Culture". Santa Maria is also called the "Heart of Rio Grande" because of its geographical location. Santa Maria stands out as the second largest concentrations of Military Organizations (OM) of the Army in the country, known as the "Armored Capital", and is now an important player in the process of restructuring the Brazilian Army.

The city of Santa Maria stands out in the regional and national scenarios as an important strategic centre for the National Defence, because it is located in the centre of the State and equidistant from the capitals of neighbouring countries to Brazil. In addition, it has an important network of roads and railroads. Thus, these were the reasons why, over time, a large number of barracks were installed in the "Heart of Rio Grande".
