Signposting and venue:

La Cabrera is located 60 km north from Madrid and 50 km from the international Madrid-Adolfo Suarez Airport. Driving instructions will be signposted from the highway A-1 E-5 E-80 Exit 60

The event centre is in a school located at La Cabrera. The navigation address is Calle de los Colegios 15, 28751 La Cabrera. GPS Coordinates 40°52'23.3"N 3°36'29.3"W

Private cars should park in the streets of the village around the event center.

Competition maps:

Long Distance:

- Scale: 1:15000 except for older and younger classes that will be at 1:10000 and 1:7500
- Contour interval: 5 m. Field survey made by Ricardo García Dengrá. The maps are printed in waterproof paper.
- Winning Times Elite Classes: 70'-80' for women and 90'-100' for men.

Middle Distance WRE:

- Scale: 1:10000 except for older and younger classes that will be at 1:7500
- Contour interval: 5 m. Field survey made by Ricardo García Dengrá. The maps are printed in waterproof paper.
- Winning Times Elite Classes: 30-35' for women & men

Sprint Distance WRE:

- Scale: 1:5000 for all classes
- Contour interval: 5 m. Field survey made by Manuel Jurado. The maps are printed in waterproof paper.
- Winning Times Elite Classes: 12-15' for women & men
