PUNCHING SYSTEM

The SPORTIdent Air + punching system will be used.

This is the touch free formula.

The organisation will provide an SPORTIdent Active Card (SIAC) for everyone.

It's not possible to use your own device.

You can test the equipment at the event centre on race day.



WINNING TIME

15 minutes.

EMBARGOED AREAS

Everything within the R36.

You're not allowed to run, read a map or test route choices in this area.

From saturday 10h00 you are no longer allowed to enter this area.

The embargo extends to anyone who through their knowledge of the terrain or the events could influence the WRE Results.



PRIZES

There will be prizes for the podium of the World Ranking Event.

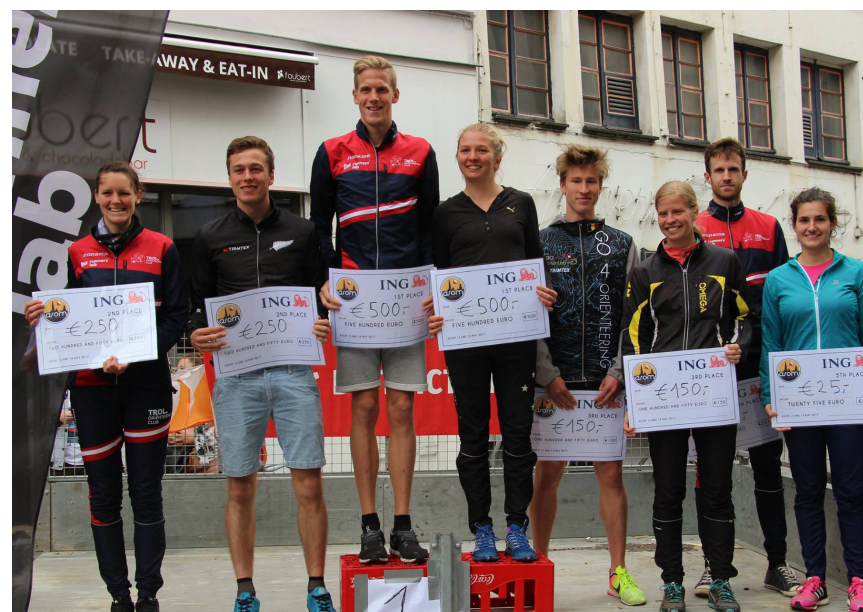
FOOD

TRANSPORT

- There are several airports in Belgium which can be used to get to Courtrai (Kortrijk). Brussels Airport is the biggest airport and Brussels Charleroi Airport and Lille France Airport are low cost alternatives.

WEATHER

The weather in Belgium in summertime is similar to other Central European countries. The average maximum temperature for June/July is about 22°C and minimum 13°C, the average days with rain a month is approximately 14.

TERRAIN

Typical city sprint terrain. The map consists mainly of urban residential areas surrounded by grassy parks in the old city centre of Courtrai.

CLOTHING

The courses are 90% asphalt and 10% grass for ME and WE. We advise normal flat running shoes. It's not allowed to run with studs.
