





### **Event Venues**





#### **Model Event**

- The Model Event is located at the Santo Antão District.
- The predominant vegetation is a pasture field with native forests. This area is similar to the region of the middle and long courses.
- Expect for hilly terrain with its altitude varying from 220 to 400m.

#### Trail-0

- The arena for Trail-O is in Santo Antão District, on the east side of the city road to São Martinho da Serra, in Santo Antão District.
- The predominant vegetation is a pasture field with native forests.
- The terrain is not very hilly, and the hydrography is formed by mostly temporary water courses.

#### **Sprint Course**

- The arena for the Sprint Course will be at Clube Recreativo Dores (Campestre).
- The terrain is not very hilly.

#### Middle and Long Courses

- The arena for the Middle and Long Courses is in the Santo Antão District, on the east side of the city road to São Martinho da Serra, in the Santo Antão District.
- Arena offers showers, food and toilets.
- The predominant vegetation is a pasture field with native forests.
- Expect for hilly terrain with its altitude varying from 220 to 400m.

### Control and Punching System



Timing: SPORTident electronic system and Helga software. No touchless available.

Athletes who have their own SI-Cards must inform their numbers when completing the Entry Form.

Athletes who do not own a SI-Card must rent one (cost: R\$ 8,00).

In case of damage or loss of the rented SI-Card, at the time of the return the athlete / club shall indemnify the organizers the amount of R\$ 190.00 (one hundred and ninety reals).

Start lists will be available at CBO and event websites by **April 12, 2018**.

The start lists for (Men and Women) elite **Long Course** (WRE) will be based on the World Rankings as on **March 31, 2018**. The best ranked runner wil start last. Non ranked runners will have their starting times determined randomly and will start before the ranked athletes.

The start lists for (Men and Women) elite **Middle Course** (WRE), will be made randomly by lot.

The starting order for other courses will be made randomly.

**The starting order** for the **Sprint course** of the **Elite classes** will be made by the **RNS** (Sprint National Ranking) and, for other competitors, by lot.

The official announcement of the results will be printed and posted in a specific place in the Event Center and published on the event website.

# Terrain Description



The area of the Model Event, Medium and Long courses is characterized by very varied terrain and vegetation: open areas (15%), semi-open pasture field (15%) and native vegetation (70%). Hilly terrain with altitude between 220 and 400 meters, with ravines, shallow and deep reentrants, stony areas, cliffs, etc.. There are some plain wire fences and barbed wire, few footpaths, many cattle tracks. April generally has temperatures between 13.5° and 24.1° C.



### The Host City of Santa Maria



The first known inhabitants of the region currently occupied by Santa Maria city were the Minuti Indians and Tapes. The city was created from camps of a demarcation commission of the bounderies between lands of Spanish and Portuguese dominion that were in the region.

During the Farroupilha Revolution (1835-1845), the first German immigrants from São Leopoldo arrived, seeking to get out of the fighting.

The city preserves historic buildings of great value, such as the Cathedral of Nossa Senhora da Conceição, Treze de Maio Theater, the Cathedral of the Mediator of the Episcopal Anglican Church of Brazil, the Caixeiral Club of Santa Maria, the National Bank of Commerce, Union Society of The Travelers' Clerks and the Belgian Village. Santa Maria hosts one of the largest public universities in Brazil, the Federal University of Santa Maria. The university currently has almost 27,000 students in its undergraduate and postgraduate courses.

By having a large amount of educational institutions, the city is known as "Culture City".

Santa Maria is also called the "Heart of Rio Grande" because of its geographical location.

The city of Santa Maria stands out in the regional and national scenarios as an important strategic center for the National Defense, because it is in the center of the State and equidistant from the capitals of neighboring countries to Brazil. In addition, it has an important network of roads and railroads. Thus, these were the reasons why, over time, many barracks were placed in the "Heart of Rio Grande".



# **Sightseeing**



- 1. **Federal University of Santa Maria**: first University of the countyside of Brazil. It has 56 undergraduate and 45 graduate courses. In the planetarium, where the sky is faithfully reproduced, there is the first Interactive Museum of Astronomy in Brazil. It is located at Av. Roraima, B. Camobi. Phone: (55) 3220 8000
- 2. **Treze de Maio Theatre**: it began its activities in 1890, it has Neoclassical architectural style. After undergoing restoration, remodeling and enlargement it was solemnly reopened. It is currently maintained by an association and offers theater, dance, music and recital shows. It is in Praça Saldanha Marinho. Phone: (55) 3028 6245.
- 3. **Calçadão:** is a great option for leisure, shopping and meetings. It has bars, restaurants, shoppings and various gastronomic and cultural options. It is in the city center, on the first block of Rua Dr. Bozano.
- 4. **Vila Belga**: built at the beginning of last century to serve as a residence for employees of the Belgian company that explored the railway system, it was one of the first housing estates in the state. The eclectic architecture of the 84 houses, with the presence of Art Nouveau elements decorating the façades, brought to Santa Maria reflections of the French "Belle Époque". It is part of the set known as Mancha Ferroviária along with the Colégio Manoel Ribas and the Estação Ferroviária, located by IPHAE as Historical and Artistic Heritage of Rio Grande do Sul. It is located at the end of Av. Rio Branco.

#### 5. Museums

**Educational Museum Gama D'Eça**: inaugurated in 1968. It brings together material of didactic, historical, scientific, paleontological and archaeological interest of the city and region. In 1981, it began to incorporate the pieces of the Victor Bersani Museum, of the Sociedade União dos Caixeiros Viajantes, totaling more than 6000 pieces in its collection. It is located at Rua do Acampamento, 81. Schedule your visit by phone: (55) 3220 9306.

**Museum Vicenti Pallotti:** inaugurated in 1935. It is considered one of the largest and most complete museums in the State of Rio Grande do Sul. It has thousands of pieces, classified in several sections: Mineralogy, archeology, paleontology, zoology, iconography, botany, war material, archeology, indigenous culture. It is located at Av. Presidente Vargas, 115. Schedule your visit by phone: (55) 3220 4565.

**Memorial Mallet:** constituted of Historical Museum and Mausoleum has a voluminous and significant collection characterizing itself in an important pole of cultural, tourist and leisure attraction. The Museum presents, in an elucidating and chronological way, the history of the Mallet Regiment and the Artillery, picturing Brazilian history from the Farroupilha Revolution. It is located at Rua Marechal Hermes, B. Passo da Areia. Visits: Tuesday to Sunday, from 8am to 5pm. Phone: (55) 3212 3388.

- 6. **Monumento ao Ferroviário:** inaugurated in 1932, it is a great option for a panoramic view of the city of Santa Maria. It is in Rua Antônio Dias, B. Itararé.
- 7. **Itaimbé Park:** it is the best known park in the city, being a place of social and leisure

integration in the city. Along the park you will find the Honey house, the Multiple Activity Center and the Concha Acústica.

10. **Historical Buildings:** Throughout the city you can contemplate buildings with architectural façades and varied styles. Near Praça Saldanha Marinho you may visit the following buildings: Caixeiral Club, Caixa Econômica Federal, former School of Arts and Crafts of the Railways and the residence of the founding rector of UFSM, Mariano da Rocha Filho - Gaúcho of the Century. The Sociedade União dos Caixeiros Viajantes (SUCV), with a beautiful external façade, is listed as a Historical Heritage of the Municipality. The building has the first elevator in the city. It is located at Rua Venâncio Aires, 1934. Phone: (55) 222 7788

#### 11. Churches

**Diocesan Cathedral Nossa Senhora da Conceição**: inaugurated in 1909. The façade presents an eclectic style, with architectural elements of several monuments of the history of art, especially of the Baroque and Neoclassical periods. In the inner part, it is enriched with works by the Italian painter Aldo Locatelli. It is located at Av. Rio Branco, 821. Phone: (055) 221 2695 **Evangelical Church of Lutheran Confession**: space inaugurated in 1873. Its bells are the first non-Catholics of Brazil and they came from Germany. It is known as "Church of the Germans", with strong element of Gothic architecture. It is located at Rua Barão do Triunfo, 1080. Phone: (055) 221 4558

**Nossa Senhora das Dores Church**: inaugurated in 1936. The façade has a beautiful sculpture of Jesus Christ with open arms. It has elements originating in medieval Italy and also aspects of baroque art. The interior painting is by the painter Lazzarini. It is located at Av. Nossa Senhora das Dores, 304. Schedule your visit by phone (055) 221 3072.

**Anglican Episcopal Church of Brazil Cathedral of the Mediator**: inaugurated in 1907, of English origin, evidences the inspiration of the Gothic style in the constructive and decorative characteristics. It is located at Av. Rio Branco, 880. Phone: 223 5677

**Shrine of the Mother Three Times Admiral of Schoenstatt**: inaugurated in 1948, it is the 1st sanctuary in Brazil. In this place began the work of the Deacon João Luís Pozzobon (in process of canonization by the Vatican. It is located at Av. Nossa Senhora da Dores, 849. Phone: (055) 222 8188

**Sanctuary Basilica Minor Nossa Senhora Medianeira**: patroness of Rio Grande do Sul, inaugurated in 1985. On the second Sunday of November it organizes the State Pilgrimage of Our Lady Medianeira, with the participation of more than 150 thousand people. It is located at Av. Nossa Senhora Medianeira, 631. Phone: (055) 221 4085

12. **ALA 4** (Air Force Barracks): created in 1970, is a remarkable place in the local landscape, thanks to the great integration it has achieved with the community. It annually organizes two great events to its visitors: in May; Mateada da Sentinela and in October; Aeronautical Exhibition (EXPOAER), one of the largest aeronautical events in the south of the country. It is located at RST 287, B, Camobi, Km 12. Phone: (055) 226 6700
