The competition will take place following the competition rules of the Finnish Orienteering Federation and the rules of the organizers.

Map: Printed map, 10.2017-03.2018, scales 1:7 500/1:10 000, contour interval 5m, field survey by Jussi Silvennoinen, updated by Lasse Vuorinen and Matti Mäkinen. The map is in a plastic case.

Map size and scale:

- Start 1 H/D21E, H/D21A, H35-45, H18-20 A3 1:10 000 H/D21AL, H50-55, H16, D35, D45-50, D18-20 A4S 1:10 000 H60-70 A3 1:7 500 D40, D55, D16 A4 1:10 000
- Start 2 all classes A4 1:7 500
- Start 3 H/D10RR ja H/D12TR **A6 1:7 500** H/D 12 **A4 1:7 500** other classes **A4 1:10 000**

Open courses A4 1:10 000.

Competition numbers: In the EVENT CENTER next to the information sign pole (self-service), own safety pins. Number bibs for the WRE-classes are at the quarantine.

Test unit (0): In the event center next to the information sign pole. Test that your EMIT works after the winter!

Rented EMITs: Available at the info. NOTE 1! If your EMIT does not work, you will NOT get a new one from the start. Check that your EMIT works already in the event center with the start unit. If your EMIT is not working, you can rent one from the info. NOTE 2! The rules of the Finnish Orienteering

Federation say: "The competitor is disqualified if s/he has used an Emit card other than the one presented to the organizer..."

Check your EMIT number is correct from the start lists. Inaccurate EMIT numbers must be corrected before the competition by email: risto.kivinen@resultfellows.com at latest by Friday 13.4.2018 at 20.00. After this, the corrections should be made at the EMIT-point of the info in the event center. EMIT numbers cannot be corrected at the start.

EMIT numbers will not be checked at the start. Those running with wrong EMIT will be disqualified as stated in the rules of the Finnish Orienteering Federation. The runner is responsible for the correct number of his/her EMIT card.

Starts: Start 1, distance 2200m. Start 2, distance 1700m. Start 3, distance 1700m. You will find the guidance to the starts at the information sign pole. You are not allowed to stray from the guided markings. The starts will be closed 15 minutes after the last start times. Open Courses start between 11.30 - 13.00.

EMIT control slips and control description: EMIT control slips at the starts. Control descriptions are printed on the maps. In addition, separate control descriptions are available at the starts. There are no fixing tools or covers for the control descriptions. For classes HD10-HD15 the control descriptions can also be seen on the info board in the event center. In the start, the competitors are called in 4 minutes before the start. For classes H/D10-15, SEE SEPARATE INSTRUCTIONS about start procedures.

In starts 1 and 2, the competitor gets the map at the starting moment. For start 3, see separate instructions. Competition model map can be seen at the start.

Quarantine zone: All WRE-classes have a quarantine zone. Distance to quarantine is 1,6 km from the event center along the route to the start. The number bibs for WRE-classes are available at the quarantine. Quarantine closes at 11.30, after which the number bibs will be removed. There is a tent with chairs in the quarantine. There is a clothes transportation from the quarantine to the event center – bring your own plastic bag or similar. Inside the quarantine zone, the use of any telecommunication devices is forbidden. This will be monitored by the organizers. There are toilets close to the quarantine. There is a drinking water available in the quarantine. There is a warm up map available for WRE-classes – A5 1:10 000.

Terrain: In the SW corner, where only the longest courses go to, the biggest height differences are over 50m, otherwise the biggest height differences are about 30-35m. Closer to the event center it is relatively flatter. The terrain has variation between bare rock hills and areas with less visibility that reduce the pace. There are some areas with cut down trees of different ages, the latest ones being made 2 weeks ago. These you will experience when closing in to the last controls. The tractor trails in these newly cut areas are marked on the map to aid in finding a better surface for running.

Children's courses cross a field near the end with several fences made of plastic markings (no electricity or barbwire). These are marked on the map and can be crossed. The organizers have also made "holes" to these fences and those are marked on the map as well.

Drinks: There are two points in the terrain where drinking water is served. Those places are marked in the map. **Drinking points are not in WRE- and childrens courses!**

Forbidden areas: All house yards are forbidden areas. There are also some separate forbidden areas that are marked on the map.

Last control: There are 2 different last controls in use. For the adults, control with code 100. And for the children, control with codes RR5 and 46. At the children's last control, one can punch at either unit. The finish corridors merge 30m before the start in a moderate downhill, BE CAUTIOUS!

Finish: There is an online finish punching at the finish line. Missing punch from the finish line leads to disqualification. The finish is closed at 15.00. From the finish, the competitors will move 400m (field road) to the event center where the personal emit unit will be downloaded.

The maps won't be collected in the finish. Following the rules, the competitors are not allowed to show the map nor course to other persons before the last starts have taken place. Similarly, showing the course from an old map is forbidden. Fair Play!

Dropping out: Competitors who drop out the race must come to the finish line or let the staff at the finish line know about it in some other way as soon as possible.

Cafeteria / restaurant: In the event center.

WC: In the event center and along the route to start 1 (600m before the start 1).

Washing: In the event center, warm water. The use of shampoo and soap is strictly prohibited.

First aid: In the event center.

Kindergarten: In the event center.

Prize giving: Prize giving ceremony for H/D21E and H/D10-20 at the event center. Other classes can pick up their prizes from the Info after the results are ready – present your EMIT card. The number of awardees is shown at the result board.

Results: The results board is located at the competition center. The results and splits can also be seen on the organizer's website: http://www.angelniemenankkuri.com/

Open courses: Courses: Open 2,5 easy = 2500m, Open 4 moderate = 4100m, and Open 6 difficult = 6000m. Map 1:10 000. Control descriptions are printed on the maps. The maps are sold in the info. The maps are sold from 11.20 onwards. Prize $10 \in$, $5 \in$ for under 18-year-olds, additional fee for EMIT rental $4 \in$. Starts between 11.30 - 13.00. You must register in the finish of open courses before you start, from where you move to the open course start. For open courses, everyone takes part at one's own risk.

Additional info: All the terrains of Angelniemen Ankkuri are CONTINOUSLY forbidden for training and competing, because all terrains have forbidden areas. The training must take place through the permission from Angelniemen Ankkuri. This is our deal with the land owners and hunting clubs. We wish that no single orienteer would break the trust between us and the land owners and hunting clubs by going in to these terrains and possibly to forbidden areas with their "own permission", even though everyman's right would allow it. All trainings and similar must be pre-agreed with Angelniemen Ankkuri.
