

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WELCOME BY THE EVENT DIRECTOR

Dear orienteering friends,

On behalf of the Organizing Committee and executive organizer Orienteering Club "Vihor" I am pleased to welcome all competitors, team leaders, officials and guests to the World Trail Orienteering Championships 2015 in Croatia. Although our country already hosted World Military Orienteering Championships twice, this will be the first IOF event of the highest level in Croatia and we are looking forward to organize it.

Orienteering club "Vihor" currently has about 100 members, including more than 15 former and current members of the National Teams in Trail, MTB and Foot Orienteering - competitors and team leaders. Our first experiences in organizing orienteering events go back to 1960's and up to now we successfully organized a few hundreds. But mostly - our club is all about loving and living orienteering. Organizing WTOC is a big honour, but yet also a big challenge for us.

Trail Orienteering in Croatia has a short history, dating back in 2004 with our first participation at WTOC in Sweden, with only one participant, while in Japan 2005 we were just observers. We can say that the new era begun with the first official team entry on WTOC in 2008 in Czech Republic. Since then we have been regularly participating in WTOC every year and our competitors won 4 individual and 4 team medals. Last one was the team gold in Italy 2014!

Croatia will host the World Trail Orienteering Championships in June 2015. We will try our best to make a fair competition with good and precise maps and fair competitive tasks for all participants. Terrains will be challenging, providing opportunities to use different orienteering skills on different types of terrains.

We are also aiming to attract more new nations to Trail Orienteering, so hopefully we will see some new competitors from South East Europe and other parts of the world participating WTOC 2015.

The event will take place in the Croatian capital Zagreb and in the nearby town of Karlovac. Most events will be held in the close vicinity of the Competition Centre. The longest distance to reach takes about 40 minutes driving from the Competition Center.

As never before, you will have the opportunity to stay in a capital city what will provide you large possibilities, not only for sport, but also for some tourist sightseeing, shopping and cultural activities. We believe you will enjoy food specialities and the unique atmosphere of Zagreb and Karlovac. If you find some extra time on your way to or from Croatia we strongly suggest visiting some of our National Parks, historic sites or even spending a few days at the Adriatic coast.

We also invite you to participate in orienteering competitions which will be held in the beautiful region of Međimurje, around towns of Varaždin and Čakovec just prior to WTOC 2015.

I wish all of you a lot of success and good preparations for our event in 2015, hoping that we will manage to organize it on the highest possible level.

VENUE

The World Trail Orienteering Championships 2015 will be held in Croatia, in the cities Zagreb and Karlovac.

Zagreb

Zagreb is the capital of the Republic of Croatia and an old Central European city. For centuries it has been a focal point of culture, science, commerce and industry. It lies at the intersection of important routes between the Adriatic coast and Central Europe.

Many famous scientists, artists and athletes come from the city, or work here. Zagreb can offer its visitors the baroque atmosphere of the Upper Town, picturesque open-air markets, diverse shopping facilities, an abundant selection of crafts and a choice of traditional cuisine. Zagreb is a city of green parks and walks, with many places to visit in the beautiful surroundings. The city entered into the third millennium with a population of nearly 800,000 inhabitants. In spite of the rapid development of the economy and transportation, it has retained its charm, and a relaxed feeling that makes it a genuinely homely city. Zagreb offers numerous theatres, museums, galleries, art collections, sport centres etc.

Karlovac

One of the events will be held in the city of Karlovac, located near Zagreb but serving as its own municipality. Karlovac is the administrative centre of Karlovac County. The city is located on the Zagreb-Rijeka highway and railway line, 56 kilometres (35 miles) south-west of Zagreb. The population of the settlement is about 56,000 inhabitants.

Croatians know Karlovac as the city of parks and the town on four rivers of which Mrežnica, Korana, and Kupa flow through urban areas, and Dobra is a few kilometers outside the city centre. One of the rarer trees found in the parks is the ginkgo biloba, which local primary school children are taken out to see as part of their classes on nature and society. Most of the parks are planted in the former trenches dug around the old military fort that were once filled with water as an added layer of protection from the intruders. One part of the city centre maintains the name of Šanac ('the Trench') after the old trenches which preserve the old hexagonal form of the historic centre.

COMPETITION RULES

The Competition Rules for IOF Trail Orienteering Events (**valid from 1 January 2015**) shall apply to the World Trail Orienteering Championships 2015. Copy of the Rules is available for download from the Rules section in the official IOF website (www.orienteering.org).

The following deviation of the Competition Rules applies:

Rule 3.3: *The programme shall include a two-day PreO competition with one course on each day, and a Tempo competition. **The Tempo competition will have a qualification and final on the same day.** The second day of the PreO competition is also the World PreO Team Championship competition.*

Rule deviation: ... ***The Tempo competition will have a qualification and final on different days.*** ...




EMBARGOED AREAS


Yellow area (4) is open for all regular human activities except Trail Orienteering.




LAKE BUNDEK - Opening Ceremony

 Parking to CC ~ 200 m



Relay - Competition Centre: 45.824136, 16.019573 (big stage near Vidikovac (the Viewing point) - follow the main alley from the main entrance to the park)


Terrain: city park; continental forest; some open areas; low hills; many terrain details; small watercourses, usually dry in summer; lakes.

Most paths are paved (hard gravel), some unpaved but firm forest paths.

Note that in some parts of the terrain (urban areas) there might be some magnetic disturbances which could influence your compass readings.



SESVETE - PreO 1



Parking: 45.833729, 16.105841 (Gimnazija Sesvete (middle school), Bistrička ul. 7)
Distances: Hotel Aristos ~ 22 km; Hotel I ~ 33 km

Competition Centre: 45.840270, 16.104442 (Rasadnik Brestje (nursery garden), Grička ul. 12)

Parking to CC ~ 900 m

Vehicles with paralympic competitors are allowed to come up to the CC to disembark, but they must leave as soon as possible and be parked at the designated parking. Please, note that the road to the CC is quite small and it will be difficult to maneuver if many vehicles come at once.

Map: DIVJAČA, 1:4000, e=2.5m, ISSOM (45.85006, 16.0960)

Previous map: 1:10000, e=5m, 1989, ISOM

Terrain: continental forest; hills with terrain details; watercourses which can be dry in summer.
Unpaved forest paths, occasionally narrow, could be soft in case of heavy rain.

It is strongly recommended to use wheelchairs with larger wheels and higher bottom clearance, if possible.
In CC there will be running water available to clean the wheelchairs after the competition if necessary.

All paths have been drawn correctly, but depending on weather conditions and “traffic” in the forest, small paths tend to change (appear/dissappear, “float around”) very quickly, so they are not the most reliable orienteering markers.


Please note that some areas of the forest have been destroyed by a storm and recently there have been extensive forestry works in the terrain, so it is possible that some of those changes are still not in the map. However, areas around the control sites should be OK.

A week before the competition watercourses still have some water, but they might be totally dry in time of competition. Final information about that will be given at TOM.

In flat areas some land features (depression, pit, erosion gully...) are drawn smaller than the usual ISSOM standard.

In the middle of the course there will be improvised very basic toilet.

Use of mosquito repellent is strongly advised.



KARLOVAC - TempO Qualifications



Parking: 45.495638, 15.557962 (Vatrogasna cesta)
 Distances: Hotel Aristos ~ 52 km; Hotel I ~ 48 km

Competition Centre: 45.486351, 15.559327 (athletics stadium near the river Korana
 (*Foginovo kupalište*))
 Parking to Start Quarantine ~ 400 m
 Parking to CC ~ 1400 m

All competitors have to go from Parking to the Start Quarantine first - **DON'T** go to the Competition Centre before you finished the course, because you will be disqualified!

All unnecessary things can be left at Start and will be transported to the Finish.

Map: KARLOVAC, 1:4000, e=2,5m, ISSOM (45.49167, 15.5581)

Previous map: 1:5000, e=2,5m, 2010, ISSOM

Urban area and city parks; flat terrain with subtle terrain details; open and semi-open areas; river runs through the terrain. All paths are paved (asphalt, hard gravel).

Part of the terrain is an arboretum with many different kinds of trees. Please see a special section in this bulletin about mapping style used for those features.


The highway between Zagreb and Karlovac is a toll road. One way fee is 19 HRK. There is an alternative toll free route via Jastrebarsko, but it takes much more time since that is a local road through the villages.

Note that on the day of the competition there is a national holiday in Croatia, so there could be a lot of traffic on the highway.


There is a nice public beach on the river Korana next to the Competition Centre and water temperature could be warm enough for swimming. Public beach will be officially opened. Unfortunately, the beach is not adapted for wheelchair users, but there are some options to reach the water - please, see at the location if you are interested.

After the TempO Qualifications there will be small ceremony of allocation of the start numbers for the Finals.

At the same place, after the TempO Qualifications, there will be held a FootO Sprint event. Competition is open for all. WTOC competitors are welcome and allowed to participate and there will be a special course for paralympic competitors too.



BLATO - TempO Finals, PreO Model 2, PreO 2

Distances: Hotel Aristos ~ 15 km; Hotel I ~ 4,5 km

Competition Centre: 45.777771, 15.896666 (Golf & Country Club Zagreb)

Parking to CC ~ 100 m

Map: BLATO 1:4000, e=2m, ISSOM (45.77974, 15.8921)

Previous map: doesn't exist

Terrain: golf course; open and semi-open areas; flat terrain with numerous subtle terrain details; lakes.

There are no paths. Competition route goes over the short grass. Areas where competitors are allowed to go will be marked by tapes. The route marked in the map is just symbolic and doesn't correspond exactly with the tapes on the terrain, where allowed areas are much wider. Tapes and taped corridors are not to be used for positioning.

On a sunny day, strong sun protection and enough liquid is strongly advised, as there is not much shade.



COURSES

All courses are set by Zdenko Horjan.

All competition maps are brand new (2013-2015), made by Ivana Gobec.

Refreshments and toilets will be available in start and finish areas of all competitions and there will be at least one refreshment/toilet station along the course. At Model events refreshments and toilets will be available in the assembly areas.

All timed stations will be set in TempO style (all maps in hands at once; one time measuring).

At most timed controls competitors will approach the station with their view covered by umbrella.

COURSE SETTER'S NOTES

The main method for solving most of the tasks at competitions should be precise map and terrain reading.

Of course, sometimes will be needed to use other techniques or combination of them, just to be sure. Therefore the local magnetic north declination has been checked and north on the map is aligned with magnetic north, and many bearings and sighting lines have been checked too. The perfect map doesn't exist and probably it is still possible to find a misleading line, so it is not recommended to make your decisions based only on sighting lines or just bearings.

Flag positioning accuracy

Positions of the flags which are supposed to be the correct ones have been set as precisely as possible according to our point of view.

In the case of planned Zero-answer task we took into account map accuracy and interpretation tolerance.

That means, either the closest flags are at least double tolerance distance away from the correct spot defined by the course setter, OR on the same feature but clearly on the other side (east/west, north/south, top/foot, upper/lower), OR in case of point feature at least 135° from the correct side.

TempO stations are located near CC. Start of PreO course is at CC. Timed control for PreO is at the end of the course (500m walk to CC). Competitors can choose what to do first TempO or PreO.

At the Model use of SI Cards will be demonstrated for those who are not familiar with the system.

Courses will be open from 10:00 - 14:00.

First start is at 10:00. There is 1 timed station before the Start and 1 after Finish (3 tasks each). Quarantine at the Finish until 12:30. Competitors can leave their unnecessary things packed in bags at Pre-Start and they will be transported to the Finish.

Course is separated in 2 parts. There is an untimed break between the parts, 200 m long. At the break section there will be refreshments and toilets available. At the Finish of the Part 1 map and control card will be taken and competitors will get the new ones at the start of Part 2.

First start is at 10:00. All competitors have to be in the Start Quarantine by 10:00. There is a toilet/refreshment along the course, which can be used after solving the station 6.

After the Qualifications (15:00) there will be short public ceremony of allocation of the start numbers for the Finals. All finalists are expected to participate in the ceremony.

First start is at 10:00. All finalists have to be in the Start Quarantine by 9:30. From there they will be transported to the Start. At the Start there will be set 1 self-service Warm Up station. There is a toilet along the course, which can be used after solving the station 3.

There are 7 stations with 5 tasks at each. Last 2 stations of the TempO Finals are public. Come and see the best TempO competitors in action!

After the Finals (12:30) there will be Flower Ceremony for the winners.

Distance from the Competition Centre to the Start is 900 m (no climb). On request, paralympic competitors with walking difficulties can be transported to the Start.

First start is at 10:00. There is 1 timed station before the Start and 1 after Finish for all + 1 station for members of the Teams (3 tasks at each station). All competitors have to be in the Start Quarantine by 11:45. Competitors can leave their unnecessary things packed in bags at the Start and they will be transported to the Finish.

Course is separated in 2 parts. There is an untimed break between the parts. At the break section there will be refreshments available. At the Finish of the Part 1 map and control card will be taken and competitors will get back their map and the new control card at the Start of Part 2.

There is a toilet on the course (marked in the map) and competitors are allowed to use it, but the course time doesn't stop while in the toilet.

At two places on the course there is a one-way corridor, marked on the map, as well as on the ground. That means, competitors are not allowed to go back once they entered the corridor.

Don't forget to punch all the controls BEFORE you enter the ONE-WAY corridor!!!

CEREMONIES

Opening ceremony

Opening ceremony will be held on June 23 in open amphitheatre at the Lake Bundek in Zagreb. The program will start at 17:00 with the team parade (approx. 500m walk; paved paths). All participants are kindly asked to gather at the designated parking place around 16:30. One of the athletes from each team should be appointed to carry the national flag (provided by the organisers). The ceremony will last about 1 hour.

** In the case of really bad weather, ceremony will be held at the Hotel Aristos. Please, follow the information from the Event Office.*

Allocation of the start numbers for the Tempo Finals

After the Tempo Qualifications, on June 25 at 15:00, there will be public allocation of the start numbers for the Tempo Finals. Ceremony will be held in Karlovac, at the Competition Centre near the river Korana (*Foginovo kupalište*).

Flower ceremonies

The Flower ceremony for discipline Tempo will take place immediately after the Finals on June 26 at 12:30, at the Golf & Country Club Zagreb in Blato.

Award ceremonies

Award ceremonies for all disciplines and categories (Tempo, PreO Open, PreO Para, PreO Team) will take place at the Golf & Country Club Zagreb in Blato after the PreO competition on June 27 at 16:00. The top 6 athletes / teams are asked to assemble near the podium 10 minutes prior to the ceremony.

Closing ceremony & Banquet

The Closing ceremony & Banquet will be held at the Hotel Aristos on June 27, starting from 20:00. Banquet will be a full course sit-down dinner. Apéritif + four drinks are included. More drinks can be bought from the bar. There will be live music. Dancing is appropriate and welcome behaviour.

Pre-ordered banquet tickets will be given to the teams at their registration on arrival. Additional tickets can be bought from the Event Office, for the full price (35 EUR), while they are available.

For all ceremonies please follow the dress code as described in the chapter Competition Clothing.

TIMEKEEPING

On PreO courses SPORTident system (SI) will be used for timekeeping and that will be the only relevant course time. Manually measured time is for backup purpose and it will be used only in case of system malfunction.

Both PreO courses consist of 2 parts. It is the competitor's responsibility to use the SI-Card properly and punch all the SI stations (CLEAR, CHECK, START 1, FINISH 1, START 2, FINISH 2).

For competitors who don't have their own SI-Card, organisers will provide it free of charge, but in case of loss, fee of 50 EUR will be charged. Please, don't loose it and return it after the competition!

ANTI-DOPING

Doping is forbidden. The *IOF Anti-Doping Rules* apply to all IOF events and the IOF Council may require doping control procedures to be conducted.

Competitors under medical treatment should obtain any required TUE (therapeutic use exemption) certificate and hand it in the Event Office before the first appearance at the competition.

COMPETITION CLOTHING

Please note that the Golf & Country Club Zagreb (venue of TempO Finals, Model Event 2, PreO Day 2) is a private golf course where certain dress code applies to all visitors.

- For WTOC competitors and team members a normal sport outfit of a national team is acceptable, with sun and rain protection as usual. Spike shoes or similar are strictly forbidden on the golf terrains.
- For all accompanied persons and visitors dress code is not strict, but generally all are asked to wear appropriate and acceptable clothes in good, neat and clean standard. Sleeveless shirts, gym shorts, mini-skirts and beach sandals are not allowed.

Any guest or competitor who doesn't adhere to the above dress code may be asked to leave the Clubhouse or the golf course.

For all other events there are no special regulations concerning the type of footwear or clothes on the terrain, however it is recommended to protect yourself against insects (mosquitoes, ticks) and weather (sun, rain).

During ceremonies the following dress code for athletes applies:

- Opening ceremony: national team uniform.
- Flower ceremonies: national team's competition uniform.
- Public allocation of start numbers & Award giving ceremonies: national team uniform (or the national team's competition uniform if there is no time to change into the national team uniform).

National flags, signs, sunglasses, hats, headbands, bottles and other such items are not allowed on the stage. Competition equipment is only allowed on the stage in flower ceremonies.

CLIMATE

Climate in Zagreb and Karlovac is continental. Average temperature in June is pleasant 19.2°C, but it's not unusual on a sunny day that temperatures raise up to 30°C or even higher, as well as it is possible to have a few rainy days in a row, with temperatures drop down below 20°C.

TRAINING POSSIBILITIES

On request, WTOC organisers can provide training maps of similar nearby terrains.

ENTRIES

According to the valid Competition Rules the following applies for competitors who intend to compete within the Paralympic class:

Rule 5.3 *Only competitors who have a permanent disability that significantly reduces their mobility are eligible to be entered for a World Championship Paralympic class competition.*

*Competitors for the Paralympic class shall submit to the IOF, at least eight weeks before the competition, an eligibility form (available at www.orienteering.org) completed by a doctor. When approved, a certificate authenticating their Paralympic status will be issued. **The eligibility certificate must be sent to the event organiser with the final entry form.***

If not sent before, payment confirmations must be presented at the registration.

Entries will not be valid until the payment of the entry fee has been paid!

CATERING

ESCORTS

Organisers will provide official escorts (“pushers”) for all competitors in wheelchairs during both PreO competitions and TempO Finals (terrains at TempO Qualifications and Model Event 1 are flat and urban with hard, paved paths, while Model Event 2 is on the golf course with short grass and no paths).

For all other events escorts will be provided for those who requested it in advance (as offered in Bulletin 3), while for late requests escorts might be provided, but that is question of availability.

TRANSPORT

Private transport

Teams, VIPs and the media representatives are free to use their own transport to all the events. There will be reserved parking areas for accredited vehicles. Car accreditation is free of charge, but cars without accreditation won't be allowed to use reserved parking - they will have to find public places which might be not so close to the Event Centre and might be not free.

Pre-ordered car accreditations will be given to the teams at their registration on arrival. Limited number of additional car accreditations might be available upon request.

Organized transport

WTOC PUBLIC EVENT

Open public event will be held during WTOC on the WTOC courses, on the same days, after the official WTOC programme. The whole event includes 1 TempO competition (WTOC Qualifications), 2 PreO competitions (WTOC Day 1 + Day 2) and 2 model events.

Entry fees are 15 EUR per competition, 5 EUR per model event or 40 EUR for the whole event.

For all juniors (born 1995 and later) entry fees are 3 EUR per competition/model or 10 EUR for the whole event.

Limited number of late entries will be accepted on site, while there are available maps.

First starting times in the Programme are provisional. All public events will start as soon as possible after the official competition. There will be no starting order. Start will be open at least for 1 hour. Please, listen to announcements by official speakers.

TRAILO RELAY DEMO EVENT

TrailO Relay demonstration event will be held the last day of WTOC (June 28, 2015).

Rules

Teams consists of 3 members. There are two classes: OPEN and PARA.

There is a short PreO course with 11 controls (different tasks for each leg on some controls) + 1 public TempO station (Zero answers possible!). There will be mass start for Leg 1. Competitors can solve the tasks in free order. Each competitor first goes to the PreO course then to the TempO station. Total allowed time for PreO course can be freely used in between the team members. Time limits are: 2 hours for OPEN class and 2,5 hours for PARA class.

For demo purposes results will be published in two ways:

- team's sum of correct answers at PreO with sum of corrected times from TempO
- team's sum of corrected times from TempO + penalty time for each wrong answer at PreO

Final entries should be made on the form EAT4 by June 24, 2015.

Teams can be mixed (don't have to be national) so if you don't have a full team (3 competitors), but would like to participate in the Relay event, please submit your entry and we will try to find you a team.

First start is at 10:00. There is 1 TempO station after Finish with 4 tasks. After competitors finish their leg and TempO station they can stay there and watch the other competitors. Second- and Third-leg competitors have to stay in the Start Quarantine until previous competitor finishes his leg. Competitors can leave their unnecessary things packed in bags at Start and they will be transported to the Finish.

FOOT-O SPRINT COMPETITION

After the TempO Qualifications on June 25, starting from 15:00, at the same place in Karlovac there will be a FootO Sprint competition (counts for Croatian Sprint Cup), organized by Orienteering Club "Jelen".

Competition is open for all. WTOC competitors are welcome and allowed to participate and there will be a special course for paralympic competitors too.

Also, at the same place there will be a Kid's race (age 0-12), starting from 13:00.

A protest fee of 50 EUR or 380 HRK shall be paid to the IOF Senior Event Adviser in cash when making a protest. The fee will be returned if the protest is accepted by the jury.


