• 3 min prior to start time Before the entrance to the first box, Emit E-card must be activated and

runners are checked

• 2 min prior to start time Control descriptions available

• 1 min prior to start time Map may be collected but should not be opened.

• 10 sec prior to start time Emit E-card is placed at the start unit until start time.

Runners must then follow the read markers to the start point which is indicated by a control flag in the terrain and a triangle on the competition map.

9. Finish

Time will be stopped at the finish when you punch the unit.
