









Access to Parking (P): from DN1 4,8 km (13 minutes by car) on an asphalted road, with often curbs, as in the map showed. The road figuring on the map will be marked in terrain, starting from the DN1 intersection.

Event Centre (EC) is situated at 200m from P, on the hill, below the water plant.

<u>Model Event area (ME)</u> is located near Competition Centre. It will be used a central place located between the stage 2 and stage 3 areas. ME map lays on one side and the other of Beliei Valley, on its hillsides being landmarks specific to the area. <u>On the ME map will be shown start corridors for stages 2 and 3 and of course, control points, placed on specified landmarks.</u> We recommend the use of Model Event map also as <u>Warm Up (WU) map for the 2nd and 3rd stages of the competition. In registration, you may choose your map scale for ME/WU, 1:10.000 or 1:7.500.</u>

Saturday 26 May, stage 1, MD

11:30 – first start

<u>The competition zone</u> is located at the foothill of Gurguiata Mountain and awaits for you to navigate through stony walls, sinkholes, hills and boulders. It offers a great challenge: it creates interesting/difficult orienteering problems, but in equal way, it provides solutions to them. It is worth it to test your powers. In the area, there are terraces on different levels (as in the sample shown below) which are good running ways. Visibility is generally good and very good. The zone is all mapped in 2017-2018.




Ionut Zinca, mapper, declares:

-"This is the most difficult map in Romania at this moment."

- "I wish you good luck and hope that you will enjoy this zone, just as I did while mapping!"

<u>The map scale</u> is 1:10.000 (MW16 – W55, M65) and 1:7.500 for the other categories.

<u>Access in the area</u> is made by going 3-4 km from the EC parking on a forest road, as in the map shown. The road will be marked.

<u>Parking for stage 1</u> will be along the forest road, starting from ending point to behind, on a distance of 900 km, influenced on the number of cars. From the ending point, you can see <u>Finish</u> (about 200m) and <u>Start 2</u> (about 100m), destined to MW12 and Open categories- except for Op. Th. Also from there, <u>Start 1 corridor</u> begin: <u>800m / 90m / 25min</u>, designated to MW14-W70/M75 categories and Open Technic.

Entrance in <u>START 1</u> is made through a <u>PRESTART</u>. From Prestart to Start 1, it is travelled a corridor of 150 m, cut through thicket, especially for the competition. From Start 1 to K control, there will be to go a corridor of about 100m, also cut through dense vegetation. Prestart will be entered in <u>minute -7</u> (calculated from each competitor's start time) and Start 1 in <u>minute -3</u>.

The SI-cards reading will be made at Finish. Competition maps will be handed over at Finish.

Sunday 27 May, stage 2, LD

10:30 – first start

<u>Competition zone</u> combines different orienteering characteristics. There are alternated long knaps and mostly smooth, with steep slopes, with areas of micro relief, with and without landslides. Also, vegetation is very different, places with clean forest and open areas, or areas of dense vegetation. Long courses use in significant proportion the new area, mapped in 2017-2018.

<u>Map scale</u> 1:10.000 (MW16 – W55, M65) and 1:7.500 for other categories.

An only start is used for all categories.

<u>Start corridor</u> (900m/ 80m/ 25 min) begins from Event Centre area and figures on Model Event/Warm Up maps and, of course, is marked in terrain.

<u>Finish</u> can be seen from Event Centre (about 200m). Maps hand over at Finish. Si-cards reading is done at EC.

Monday 28 May, stage 3, Sh.LD

• 10:00 - first start

<u>Competition zone</u> combines different orienteering characteristics. There are alternated long knaps and mostly smooth, with steep slopes, with areas of micro relief, with and without landslides. Also, vegetation is very different, places with clean forest and open areas, or areas of thicket. The area has in its west extremity an apart place, with many micro relief details, new-mapped this year. The courses from MW16 to W55, M65 have in this rare interesting/beautiful area, from 4 to 8 controls, depending on the length of the race.

The scale 1:10.000 (MF16 – F55, M65) and 1:7.500 for other categories.

The corridor heading to <u>Start 1</u> (MF16 to F60/M65 is <u>1100m /80m /30min</u> and the corridor to <u>Start 2</u> (MF12,14, F65,70, M70,75 and Open), visible from Event Centre, is <u>400m /10m /10 min</u>.

<u>The Finish</u> is visible from Event Centre zone (about 300 m). The maps hand over at Finish. The SI-cards reading is made at Event Centre.
