Athletes check in:

- 1: Friday June 22nd: 2pm to 7pm: City hall of Lans en Vercors (Follow signage)
2pm to 10pm: Training opportunities in the town of Correncon or Autrans
There will signage at the entrance of each town
- 2: Saturday June 23rd: 8:30 am: Beginning the Athletes check-in at the Lans en Vercors ski resort
12h: First athlete to start

Access to the “Long Distance Arena”

- Parking for cars and start zone are located at the Lans en Vercors ski resort
- Start and finish line area (Arena) is located 3 Kilometers away, please plan 45 minutes to walk to the area. No access possible by car, however access to the area is very easy
- Once you arrive at the “Arena”, the starting line is 3 minutes away

Long Distance (LD)

- H21: 15.2 Km distance, 625 elevation, Control points: 23
- D21: 9.1 Km 425 elevation, Control points: 15
- Two beverage stations are available
- Due to the expected weather conditions, the trails will be slippery. Please be aware of the slippery rocks covered with moss
- The race course consists of prairies with many electric fences which are not always easy to see
- The courses will cross a gated area with cows. Please make sure to use the designated gates
- GPS device are forbidden except if they have no screen or voice assistance

Miscellaneous:

- Collection of race cards: Starting at 4:30 pm on Saturday at the welcoming office of the resort
- No water available during the Long Distance Arena, even at the “Les Allieres” auberge
- Please plan for your own water supply
- There is no shuttle from the town of Lans en Vercors to the ski resort
- Reward ceremony will be on Sunday June 24th at 1pm, at the start and finish line of the ski resort
