




Both Men and Women A-finals pass through the Arena. There is no control point at the end of the passage. No arena passage for other classes.





- In relays, after competition entry deadline changes of names of the relay team members and/or their running order may only be made with a valid reason (e.g. accident or illness) and shall reach the organiser at least two hours before the start of the relay class (Rule 9.11.)


