

- 5 disqualifications and 1 complaint in the Middle Final for not following the marked route after the spectator control


































- Start, changeover, finish procedure demonstration in the arena at 11:40

- At the mass start, maps will be on the ground. First teams row 1, second and mixed teams row
 2. Step on them 1 minute before the start. Then countdown and start.













Relay map board
















Arena passage marking

Relay changeover



- No pre-warning from the organisers, this is your responsibility!
- The incoming runner must run through the finish line and then proceed to the changeover plank, where incoming and outgoing runners must change over by touching hands. Used maps to be handed over after the changeover.
- It is the runner's responsibility to pick the correct map.
- Once having finished the race it is strictly forbidden to make any kind of contact with team members inside the quarantine.













Coaches' race



- Start: 16:15 from the map boards
- Everyone accredited may run
- You should bring your own SI-Card or run without it
- M20/W20 competition maps will be used (thrown up into the air)
- Course closes at 17:15
- Results will not be available afterwards







JWOC Party programme



- Same place as Opening Ceremony
- **Opens at 18:00**
- Dinner between 19:00 20:00 for those who are on a full board plan and those who preregistered
- Disco starts at 20:00
- Party ends at 02:00 (negotiable)













Party security measures



- Coaches are asked to discuss appropriate behaviour with their competitors
- No drinks allowed to be brought into the gated compound. Water will be available inside free of charge.
- Team officials get wristbands to distribute to their athletes. Only competitors with wristbands can buy beer and wine at the counter. It's the team official's responsibility who gets a wristband.
- Age limit for buying and drinking alcohol in Hungary is 18 years.
- Coaches are asked to be present and assist in patroling the area and help athletes get home when necessary.
- Team officials carry full responsibility for their athletes' overall. The team contact number should be reachable throughout the night.
