



8. Weather

Average temperatures of Jiaxing in November; day average 20° C, night 14° C.

9. Clothing

For middle and long event, competitors must wear clothing that fully covers their body and legs.

It is forbidden to use shoes with spikes in sprint competitions.

The punching system used is SPORTident. Athletes may use their own SI-Cards. A SI -Cards can be rented for a deposit of RMB 500.
