

Important info on participation in relays

It has, after consultation with SEA and ski-O-comission, been decided to include the following text in coming Bulletins.

To allow for entry according to this before the team entry deadline 19th of January 2019 it is also published through this document on competition homepages and IOF Eventor.

It is not allowed to participate in more than one championship during the week, with these exceptions:

Participants from WMSOC and JWSOC may participate in the WSOC relay.

- All participants for the WSOC relay must be registered as WSOC participants no later than 15:00 on 19.march 2019.
- All participants in the WSOC relay must have a valid IOF athlete license.
- WMSOC participants who are registered as WSOC participants must pay the accreditation fee, which includes the banquet.
- Participation in both WMSOC middle 2 and WSOC relay is not allowed.
- JWSOC participants who are registered as WSOC participants do <u>not</u> have to pay additional accreditation fees.
- Participation in both the JWSOC relay and the WSOC relay is <u>not</u> allowed.

Participants from EYSOC may participate in the JWSOC relay.

- All participants for the JWSOC relay must be registered as JWSOC participants no later than 15:00 on 19.march 2019.
- EYSOC participants who are registered as JWSOC participants do <u>not</u> have to pay additional accreditation fees.
- Participation in both the EYSOC relay and the JWSOC relay is <u>no</u>t allowed.
