


Previous maps of the terrain: Sõmerpalu (2011022), Sõmerpalu-Soe (2013019) and Sulbi-Osula (2012067).

Map scales:

sprint - 1:5 000

middle distance – 1:10 000 long distance – 1:15 0000.

Contour interval 2,5 meetrit. Maps have been prepared in 2015. aastal.







TERRAIN:

Sandy, dry left bank of the Pühajõgi river right before flowing into Vagula lake. Up to 25 m slopes are changing with flatter areas and more gentle slopes. Marshes almost missing, coniferous forests mainly with good or excellent passability and visibility. Many different ages of clearings and young forest. Regular network of roads and paths. Sõmerpalu settlement is typical countryside borough with private and appartment buildings and green areas between them. There are motocycle cross tracks near the competition centre.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

Attachement of SI-card to bike is not mandatory. Usage of helmets is obligatory. Participants must start with complete bikes and The course shall be completed by the cyclist riding, carrying or pushing his/ her mountain bike. Competitors may carry tools and spare parts during the competition, but shall not use spares or tools other than carried by themselves or another competitors. Riding off tracks is allowed until its not marked as prohobited area on the maps. On the narrow roads slower

participants must make way on first request of a faster rider, this does not apply on the marked route to the finish. Oppositing participants should pass from right side. On the narrow road in the case of opposition climber must make way for descender.

Competitors may not use or carry telecommunication equipment between entering the pre-start area and reaching the finish in a race, unless the equipment is approved by the organizer. GPS data loggers with no display or audible feedback can be used. The organizer may require competitors to carry a tracking device and/or a GPS data logger.

START NUMBERS:

Start numbers are in use. Same numbers are used in all days. Start number should be attached in front of the bike. Organizers will provide necessary accessories for that.
