| PreO | Para & Open | 12 |
| Relay | Para & Open | 4 teams (of 3) |
| TempO | Open | 16 |

The organiser reserves the right to combine Open and para classes with less than 4 entrants.

All competitors must be full passport-holding citizens of the country they are representing.

Competitors representing other member Federations of the IOF can participate in the Championships but will not be eligible for Asian titles, medals or diplomas. Due to short daytime, the number of competitors from non-Asian Federations will be limited, which is waiting for permission from TOC.

In the relay, an Asian Federation may enter 4 teams, each of 3 competitors. Only better-placed team will be counted in the prize list.
