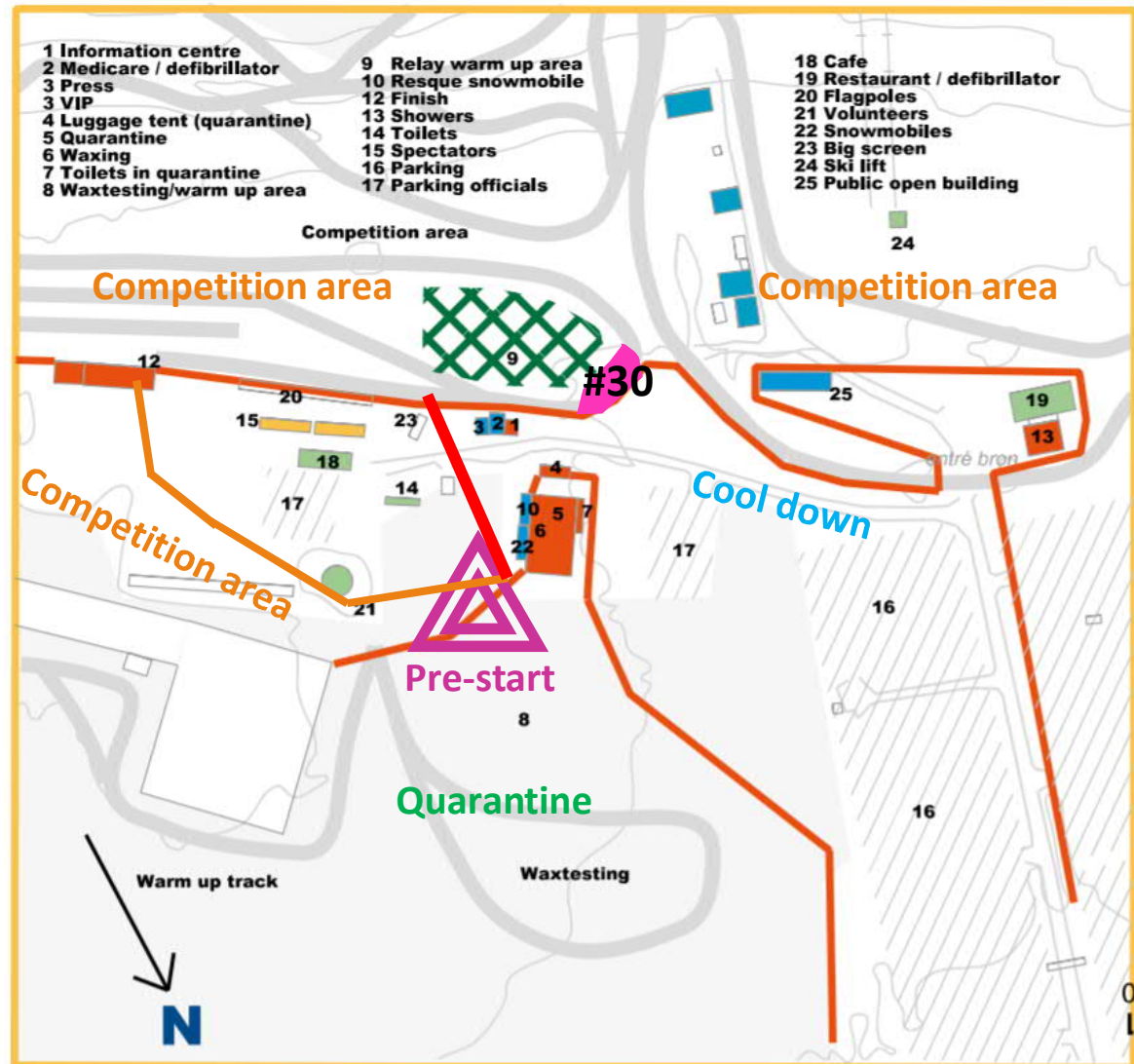

9. Map

- **Between start point and last control there are no forbidden routes or forbidden areas. This means that you are allowed to cross any corridors marked by V-boards.**
- **To start point and from last control to finish routes marked with V-boards should be followed.**
