<b>TempO</b>	Open	16	5

The organiser reserves the right to combine Open and para classes with less than 4 entrants.

All competitors must be full passport-holding citizens of the country they are representing.

Competitors representing other member Federations of the IOF can participate in the Championships but will not be eligible for Asian titles, medals or diplomas. Also, Competitors will need to apply and endorse by their Federation.

In the relay, an Asian Federation may enter 4 teams, each of 3 competitors. Only the best-placed team will be counted in the prize list.

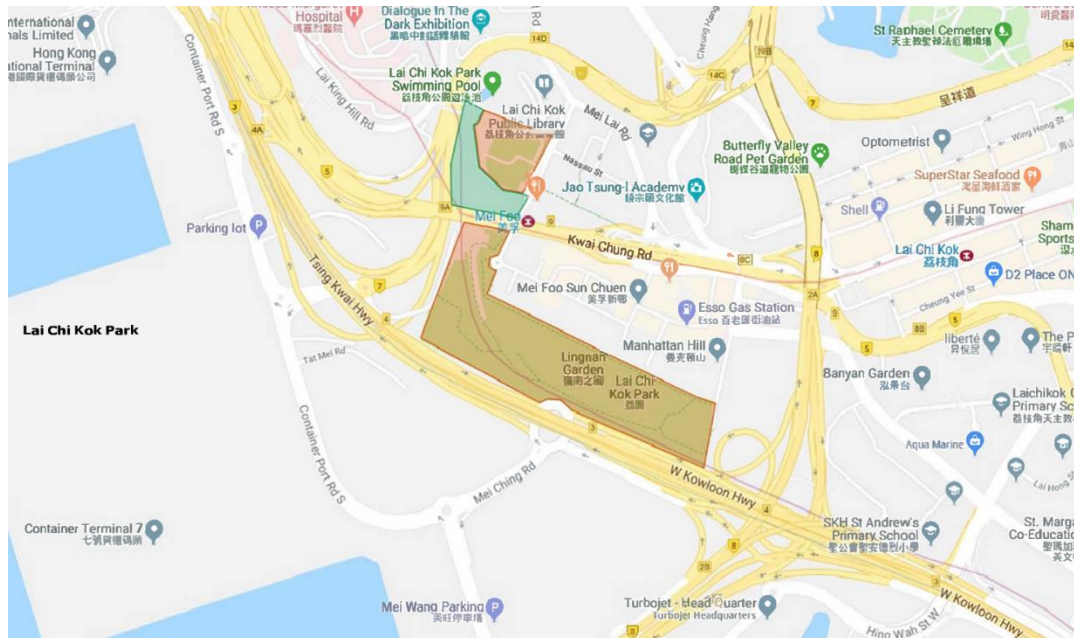

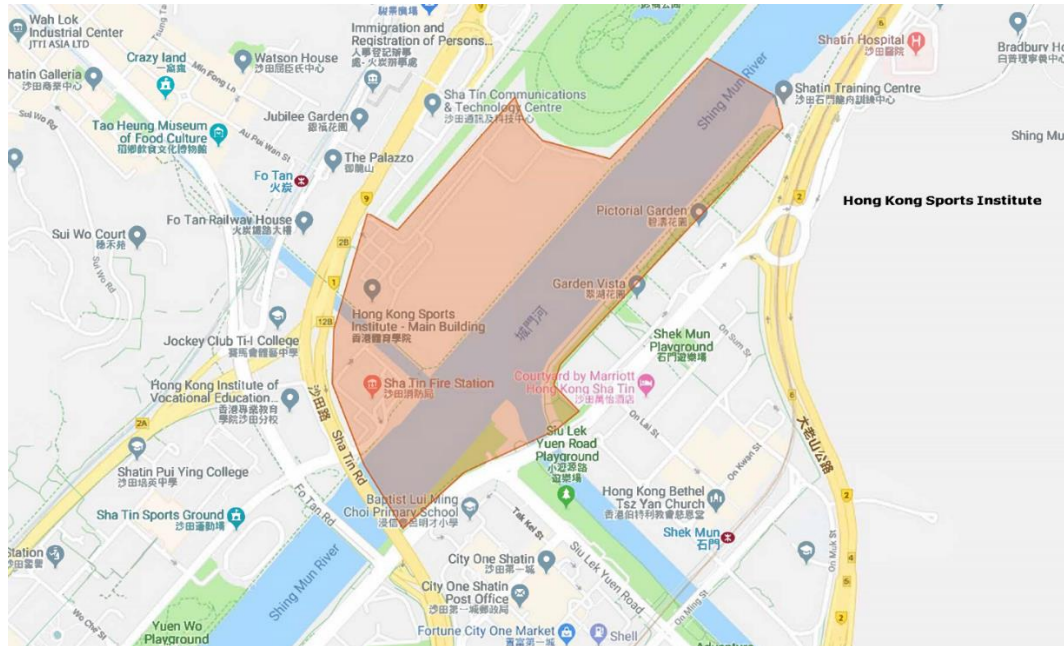

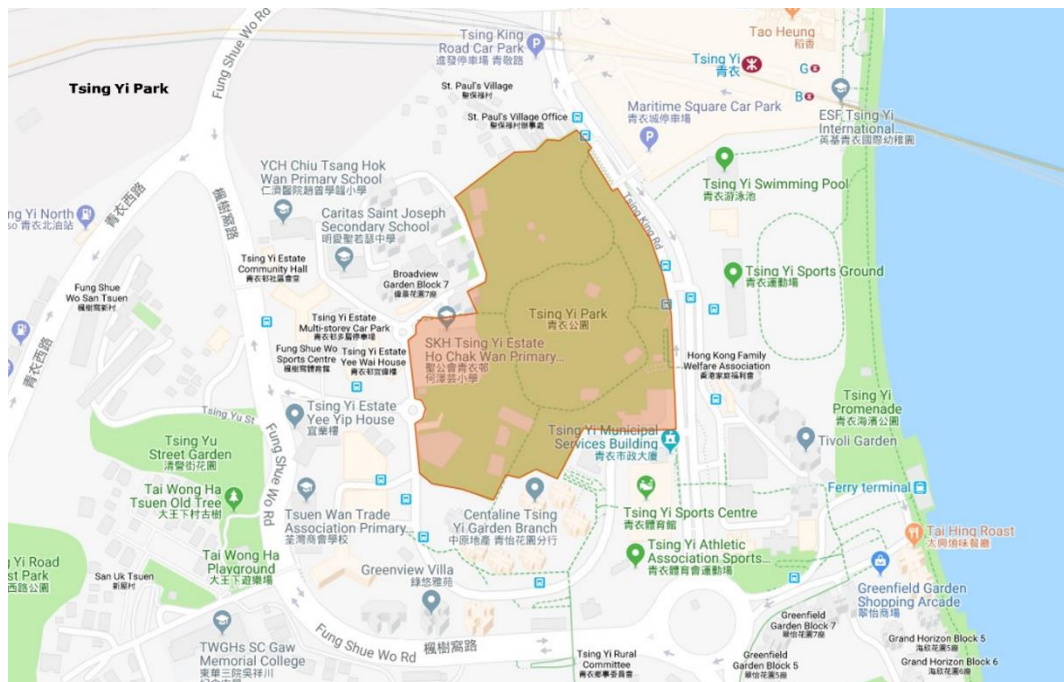

## Clothing

For AsTOC 2019, there are no regulations regarding clothing. However, during competitions, all athletes should use their national competition uniforms. The competitor must be always be identify.

There is no special recommended footwear. There may be some ticks and mosquitoes in competition terrains. Full body cover is recommended for all events.

All AsTOC 2019 accreditation and entries must be made in IOF Eventor. The entry form will be available in mid-July.

- The deadline for **Team Name** Entry is **9 November 2019**

- The deadline for **Team Size** Entry is **15 September 2019**
- The deadline **Payment** is **12 October 2019**
- The deadline for **Team Name** Entry is **9 November 2019**
