## **3. VENUE**

The World MTB Orienteering Championships is located in Liberec Region which is situated on the north of the Czech Republic. It is named after its capital Liberec that has 100 000 inhabitants. The region shares international borders with Germany and Poland. The Liberec District offers outstanding natural and cultural conditions for tourism, both in the winter (alpine as well as cross-country skiing – Krkonoše, Jizera Mountains, Ještěd ridge, but also the Luž mountains) and in the summer. ## **4. EVENT CENTRE AND COMPETITION CENTRES**

The WMTBOC **Event Center** will be situated in the **Sport Park Liberec** – <u>www.sportparkliberec.cz</u>. The complex of Sport Park Liberec includes the multifunctional hall, 45 outdoor and indoor sports facilities, restaurant and Hotel Arena. Tipsport Arena, one of the most modern multifunctional halls in Europe, is the home of the extra league ice hockey club White Tigers Liberec. It hosts both domestic and international sporting and cultural events – football tournaments, basketball games, freestyle motocross races, and concerts by leading Czech and international artists or figure skating shows.


Event Center will be site of Event Office, Opening ceremony, Team leaders meetings, Banquet and also secure bicycle storage.

#### **Competitions centres**

**Sport Complex Turnov**, competition centre for sprint, includes the athletic stadium, the sports hall, volleyball courts and the gym. The athletic stadium hosts every year Ludvík Daněk Memorial, Czech world record holder in discus throw.

**Sport Centre Břízky**, competition centre for middle, is part of the eastern shore of the dam "Mšeno" in the city Jablonec nad Nisou. The sport park offers various sport facilities – tennis, squash and badminton courts, and indoor golf. Outdoor sports places include clay tennis courts and a football field. Moreover, there is also biathlon arena where the important Czech biathlon competitions take place.

**Sport Venue Vesec**, competition centre for long and relay, is located to the south-eastern border of Liberec and was built for Nordic World Ski Championship in 2009. Nowadays cross-country competitions are organized here, and during summer sportsmen from Liberec like to go skating there.

## **5. COMPETITIONS**

#### **Competition Rules**

The "Competition Rules for IOF MTB Orienteering Events" and "Special Rules for MTB Orienteering World Cup" valid for 2015 apply. Actual version can be downloaded – <u>http://orienteering.org/</u> <u>mtb-orienteering/rules/</u>.

Riding off the tracks is not allowed and the competitors riding off the tracks will be disqualified. All controls will be situated on paths.

In the Czech Republic one drives on the right side of road. Riders must ride on the right side on all roads and tracks. Overtaking slower riders should be done by the left.

#### Permitted deviations from rules

Because of the better readability of relay map, scale 1:10 000 will be used. For that reason the map size will be  $36 \times 30$  cm.

#### **WMTBOC**

There is one class for women and one for men. There are no age restrictions. Each Federation may enter a team of unlimited number of competitors and maximum 10 of officials.

In the Middle distance and the Sprint every Federation may enter up to 6 women and 6 men and, in addition, the current World Champions for the distance may be entered by their Federation(s) provided they are members of the Federation's team.

For the Long distance competition, the number of competitors who may enter is limited. The specifics of the qualification procedure are available on the IOF website at <u>http://orienteering.org/wp-content/uploads/2010/12/Procedure-for-allocating-WMTBOC-long-distance-start-slots.pdf</u>. Competitors that do not qualify for the A final will be assigned to the B final.

In the Relay, each Federation may enter two women's team and two men's team, each consisting of 3 team members. Incomplete teams and teams with cyclists from more than one Federation are not allowed.

#### **JWMTBOC**

Each Federation may enter a team of up to 12 competitors — up to 6 women and 6 men — and a maximum 10 of team officials.

In each competition every Federation may enter up to 6 women and 6 men.

In the Relay, each Federation may enter two women's team and two men's team, each consisting of 3 team members. Incomplete teams and teams with cyclists from more than one Federation are not allowed.

#### **Time-keeping system**

The punching system used in all competitions will be SPORTident. SIAC (SI active card) will be rented to all competitors for the whole Event as part of starting fee. Although all competitors will be equipped with SIAC, standard contact punching system will be used at all control points. System Air plus will be active only for contact-less finish time keeping.



#### Quarantines

Competitors will be quarantined on all individual competitions before the start. After finishing there will be quarantine only for the first riders in the finish, till the beginning of the start quarantine (sprint and long). Start-quarantine area is equipped with toilets, tents and water. In quarantine area it is not allowed to use phones, computers or any other multimedia devices that can help you to follow the competition online. After finishing it is not allowed to go to the Start-quarantine zone. All of your belongings will be delivered to the finish area by organizers.



Long	1:15000, E 5m	The Long distance area has broken sub- montane terrain in a hilly spruce forest with many valleys and ridges. The whole competition area is covered with a net- work of forest roads and paths with a varied rideability.	Sport Park Vesec

The whole competition area is covered with a network of forest roads and paths with a varied rideability. Part of the Relay event (around the finish area) is situated in a cross-country skiing area. There is an open area with isolated trees. Some paths in this area are led through open meadows. In the terrain, these paths can be recognized by the lower grass cutting. 
