- ABOUT THE REGION

Khanty-Mansiysk autonomous okrug - Ugra

Location: Khanty-Mansiysk autonomous okrug-Ugra, Western Siberia, Russian Federation

Area: 250.93 sq. km Population: 99 387people

The average annual temperature: 1,10°

At the present time the Khanty-Mansiysk autonomous okrug — Ugra is an independent subject of the federation, with the population of 1663798 people; with about 2% of them are indigenous small-numbered people of North: khanty, mansi and forest nentsy who are still leading a traditional lifestyle.

Khanty-Mansiysk experiences a subarctic climate. The climate is extreme, with temperatures as low as -49 C and as high as 34.5 C. However the region is very cold with an average temperature of 1.1 C. Precipitation tends to be fairly low; 553 millimeters per year.

The Khanty-Mansiysk autonomous okrug-Ugra is taking leading positions among other subjects of the Russia in terms of the manufacturing, electricity production, oil and gas production, volume of investment in the new capital stock and tax income into the budget system.

Today, the Khanty-Mansiysk autonomous Okrug-Ugra is mostly famous for the oil production. The region produces around 7% of the world oil production and about a half of the Russian. There are 475 oil and gas deposits opened on Ugra territory. The total length of the pipe work is 102 938 km.

There are 50 types of sports developing in Khanty-Mansiysk autonomous Okrug-Ugra.

The main ones are: cross-country skiing, biathlon, athletics, snowboarding, ice-hockey, sledge-hockey, water polo, chess and mini football.

Besides, Ugra is known everywhere as a place of holding the major national and international sport competitions. The major sports competitions of Khanty-Mansiysk are Biathlon Championships and the world cups, water polo World Cup, World Chess tournaments, Oil countries boxing Cup, Cross-country skiing and biathlon championship for the disabled, III All-Russian summer Universiade and etc.

VENUE

The Alexander Filipenko Winter Sport Center, Khanty-Mansyisk, Russia

The Alexander Filipenko Winter Sports Center was put into operation in December 2000: stadium, shooting range, stands, which are able to host more than 10 000 spectators, sports school, roller-ski tracks, bridges and tracks, sports club, and hotel complex. Construction of the first press-center and building of team cabins was finished in 2002.

The center, which is located in the down town on the level of 83 meters above sea, was reconstructed to the IBU Biathlon World Championships 2011. The course passes on the height from 25 to 115 meters above sea level.

CLASSES AND PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS

ESOC: W/M21E World Cup: W/M21E

Competitors representing member Federations of the IOF, defined by the International Olympic Committee as belonging to the European continent, can compete in ESOC.

Competitors representing other member Federations of the IOF can participate in ESOC but will not be eligible for European titles, medals or diplomas.

In the individual competitions a Federation may enter a maximum of 6 competitors in each class. The current European Champion shall be given a "wild card" for the red group in addition to the ordinary entries from his/her federation. There shall be no limit on the number of competitors and leaders in a team.

The organising Federation may have two additional competitors as official ESOC competitors in the individual competitions. These competitors shall start in the lowest ranked start group.

In the relay a Federation may enter 2 teams each consisting of 3 competitors, but only the better-placed team will count in the results list. In the sprint relay a Federation may enter 3 teams each consisting of 2 competitors, but only the best-placed team will count in the results list.

MAP AND TERRAIN

Map from 2013 renewed in May 2109. Mapper Sergey Myatovich. Competition terrain is part of nature park «Samarovskiy Chugas». Competition area contains three different types of terrain.

There are some slightly undulating areas on hilltops, areas with spurs and gullies with different steepness on slopes, height differences up to 50 m and some areas with very deep valleys and steep slopes, height differences up to 85 m. Forest is mostly coniferous, dominating tree is cedar.

Runnability is good in 30% of the forest, in 65% there is some undergrowth, in 5% there are fallen trees and very thick undergrowth. In bottoms of the valleys small streams and marshes occur.

The issuance of the Russian visa for athletes of the European Union countries and China is executed according to the invitation letter from the organising organization (invitation from OC).

Other countries:

Russian visa for participants from Non-European Union countries is issued through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russian Federation.

TRANSPORT

Travel to Khanty-Mansiysk

The air companies «Utair» and «Aeroflot» offer regular flights from Moscow to Khanty-Mansiysk. The air companies perform daily flights route: Moscow - Khanty-Mansiysk - Moscow.

Nearest airports to Khanty-Mansiysk are Surgut (300 km), Nizhnevartovsk (510 km), Tyumen (670 km), Yekaterinburg (996 km). There are direct air flights from these towns to Khanty-Mansiysk with the exception of Surgut. You can get from Surgut to Khanty-Mansiysk by regular bus (travel time is 4 hours).

- OVERVIEW MAP OF EMBARGOED AREA AND TRAINING AREA






