Meeting place & parking

Access to [parking](#) only from Samsøgade 52, 9000 Aalborg. Follow signposting from Østre Allé.

Transport by private car or by bus route 13 from Aalborg bus terminal towards Gug Øst. Get off at “Eternitten”, which is within walking distance from the arena.

**Event centre**

Event centre/arena is located in the northern part of the Eternitten area.

The map is newly drawn according to ISSprOM 2019, printed on offset water- and tear-proof paper. It is expected to achieve DOF's quality mark.

Terrain

The Eternitten area is a relatively new development in an area formerly home to a fibre cement plant. The neighbourhood is primarily residential, with offices and outlets interspersed with green spaces. A few of the original industry buildings have been preserved.

The Blegkilde neighbourhood is characterized by a mixture of detached homes, public institutions and green spaces.

The event area offers considerable variation in elevation.

Eligibility

The event is open to all members of clubs registered with Dansk OrienteringsForbund (DOF) or International Orienteering Federation (IOF).

The open courses are open to everyone, including those not organized by a DOF club.

Classes

Course distances follow DOF's 2019 regulations, section 4.1.2.1.

Final course distances and checkpoints to be announced in the instructions.

Classes W18, W20, M18, M20, W21 and M21 will be seeded by DOF.

Winning times are 12–15 minutes for all classes.

Punching system	<p>EMIT timing is used.</p> <p>Competitors using their own eCard must supply their number at entry.</p> <p>A hire eCard is issued to competitors who fail to supply their eCard number at entry.</p> <p>Failure to return a hire eCard incurs a charge of DKK500.</p> <p>Competitors who have forgotten their own eCard may hire a replacement eCard from the event office on the day. The price is DKK20.</p>
Start	<p>Individual start with 1-minute intervals; first start at 10.00am.</p> <p>An interval of at least 15 minutes is required between the start list for elite classes (W18, M18, W20, M20, W21, M21) and other classes. Other classes are expected to start from 11.30am.</p>
Quarantine	<p>Competitors in classes W18/M18, W20/M20 and W21/M21 must be present in the quarantine area no later than 9.30am.</p> <p>Transport of covering clothes from the quarantine area to the event arena (Finish) will be arranged.</p> <p>No parking in the quarantine area.</p>
Distances	<p>The distance from parking area to event arena is about 200m.</p> <p>Shower facilities are available at the home of Aalborg Orienteringsklub, Stolpedalsvej 4, Aalborg, about 3.5km from the parking area.</p>
Commentary	<p>Race commentary will be provided.</p>
Children's course	<p>A no-fee children's course is available near the event arena. Participants will be awarded a small prize.</p>
Accommodation	<p>Local accommodation must be expected to be scarce, as Aalborg is hosting its carnival and other events over the weekend. In Himmerland, the Made In Denmark golf tournament takes place 19–24 May.</p>

Kiosk There will be no kiosk facilities. Near the event arena is a Føtex supermarket with bakery.

For competitors organized under DOF, all other entries take place via their club at [O-Service](#).

Late entry is open until Wednesday 20 May, 2020, 10.00am. A higher start fee is charged, except for open courses.

Results Results will be published continually at the event arena and online. After the race, results will be available on the website.

Prizes Winners of W21 and above and M21 and above are awarded DOF's championship medal. Competitors finishing second or third are awarded DOF's championship medals.

Competitors finishing first, second or third in other championship classes are awarded DOF's championship medals, under the regulations' section 4.1.5.

Medals are awarded only to persons who, on the day of the event, are members a DOF club **and** are Danish nationals **or** registered with the Danish National Register (folkeregistret).

Løberen League Elite sponsor gift vouchers are given to competitors finishing first, second and third in M/W20.
