RESULTS

- The results of each day of the competition are determined by the less time of passing the distance.
- Results of 3 days of competitions are determined by the highest amount of participant points.
 - Participants' points () for each day of competitions are calculated according to the following formula: $E=100\cdot \left(1-\frac{T_y-T_\Pi}{T_\Pi}\right)$, where Ty time of the participant on the distance, T\Pi time winner.
- The result of a participant, who hasn't completed one or more distances or has been disqualified, shall be placed in the final protocol below all participants who have completed all distances.

The rental price is paid together with entry fees and does not depend on the time of payment.
















