# Terrain

The long distance offers northern coniferous forest with moderate to locally strong hump. The northern area has some steep ridges, deep death ice pits and varied visibility, while other parts are fairly flat with good visibility. In the area there is a dirt road that today is fully accessible.



## Note

Some of the slopes in the northern part are VERY steep.  
Dangerous areas are marked as forbidden areas, and are out of bounds.  
The most critical parts are marked in the terrain with blue/yellow ribbons

Some of the tracks are marked with sign "steep slope".

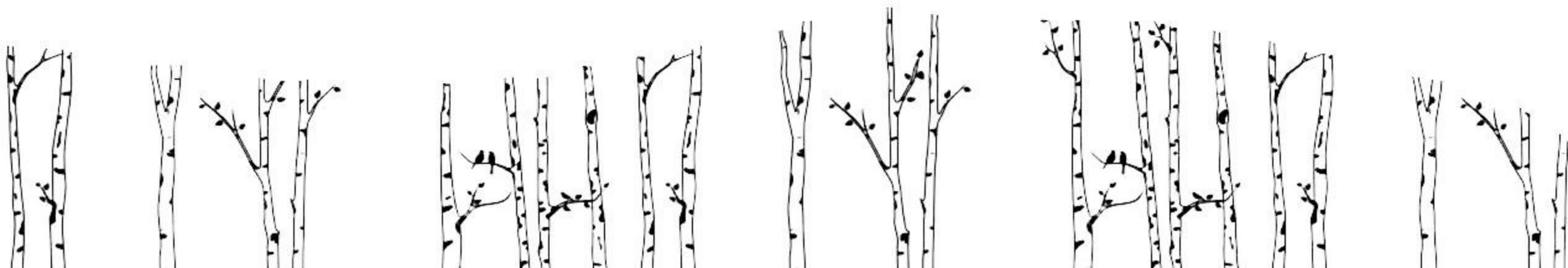

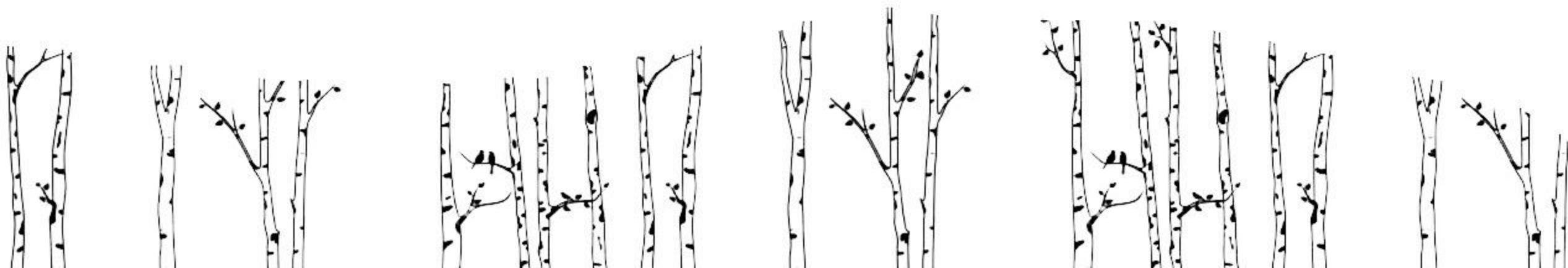


## Scandic Syd
