

Terrain-description	Typical Danish beech wood with smaller areas of coniferous forest. There is a			
	larger area with old beech wood with very little undergrowth. This area is			
	moderately hilly and sloping towards the North. Plenty of tracks and ditches are			
	found in the forest. A few streams are deep and may be difficult to cross. The			

north-eastern part consists of an area with self-sown beech and small areas where deciduous and coniferous forest is mixed.
