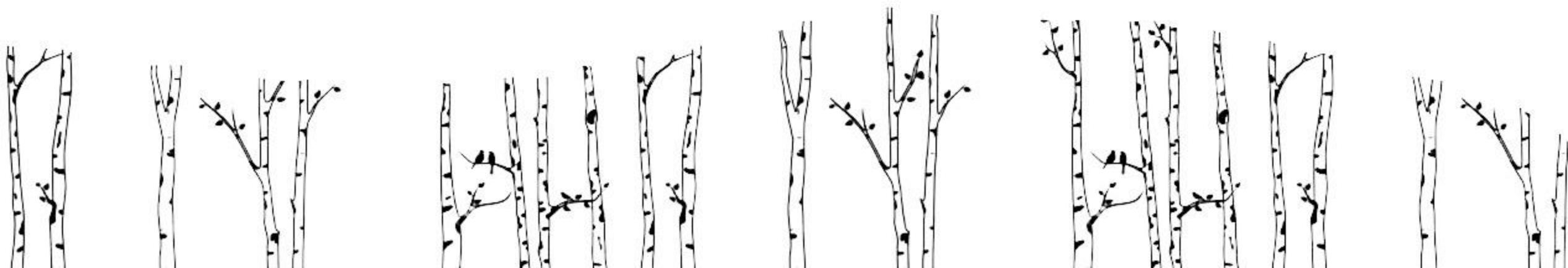

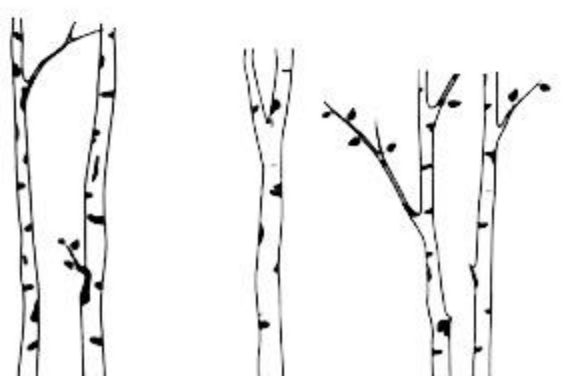
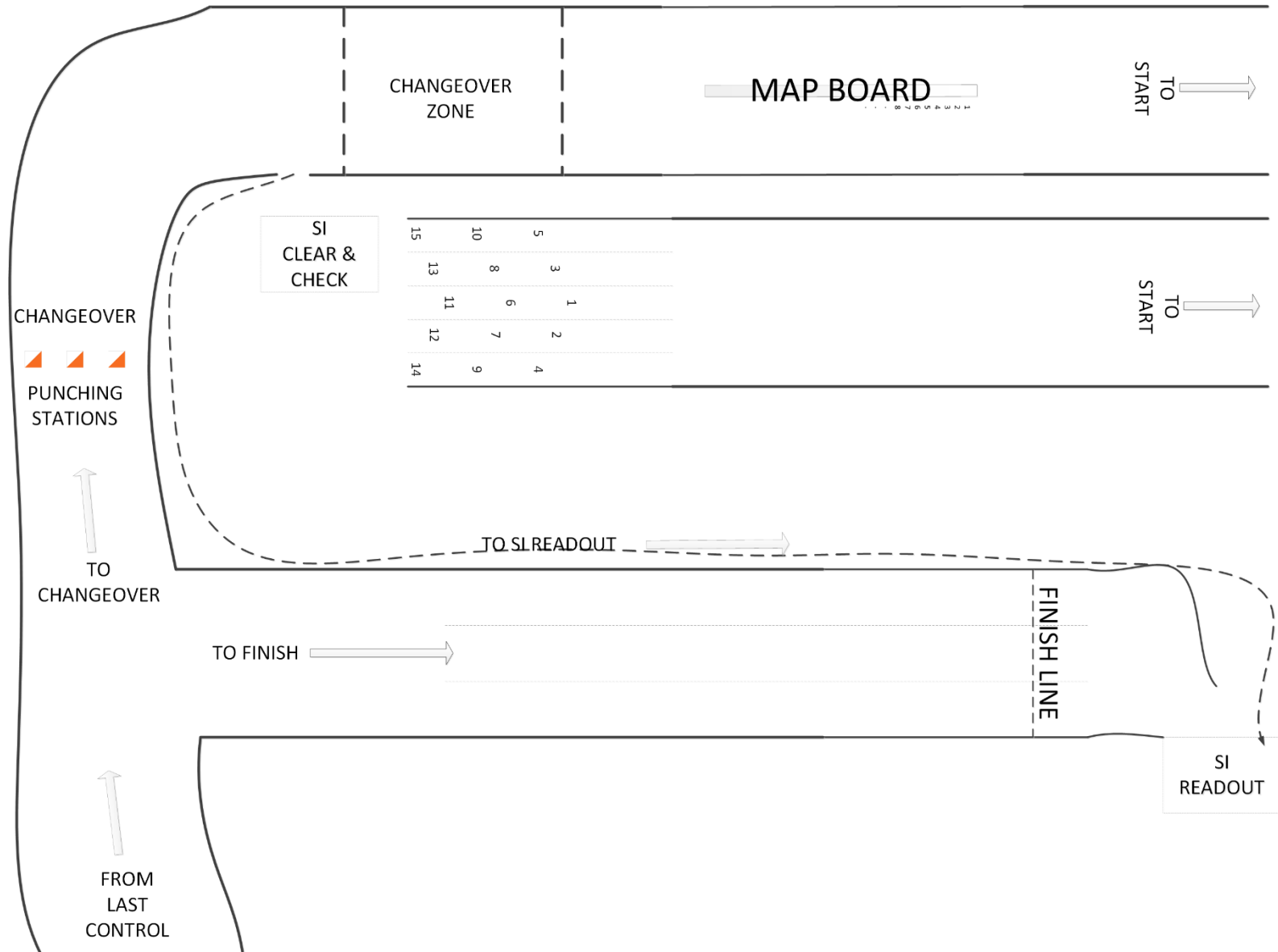

Terrain

The terrain is very similar to that in middle race

The athletes will meet a quite flat area of pine trees with high forest mixed with an area of cross-steep ridges and deep dead ice pits. (A smaller number of cutted areas and green areas will affect all courses.)

The paths will pass a summer cottage area, in which plot land is prohibited to enter.

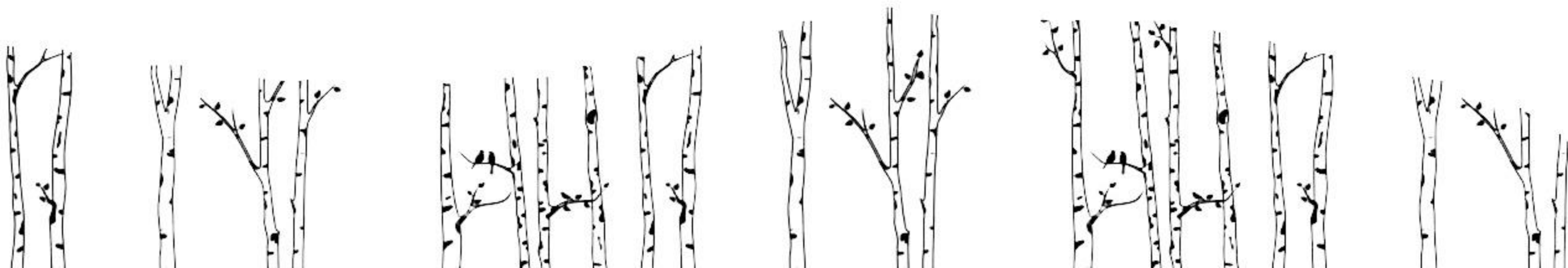


Maps

Finish procedure

Time will stop when passing the finish line

Two finish judges rules on the final placings, also a jury member are present at the finish line. As a back-up a camera recording the finish. The placings in a close finish are determined by the competitors' front foot crossing the finish line.

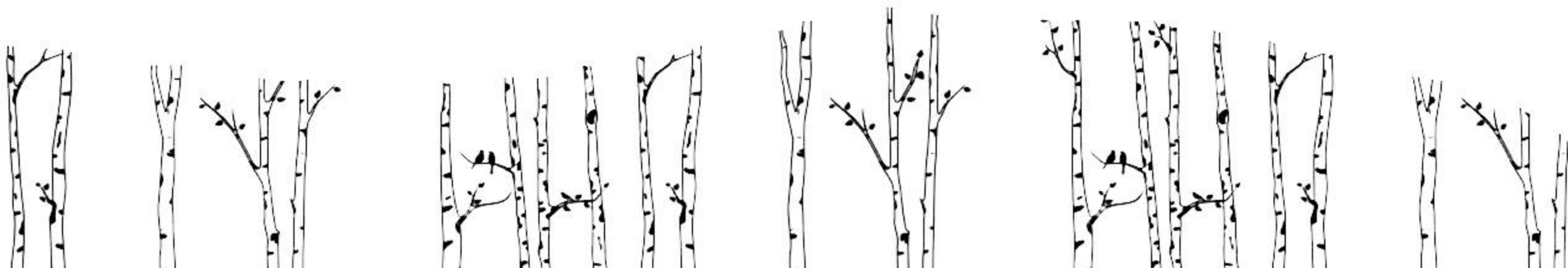

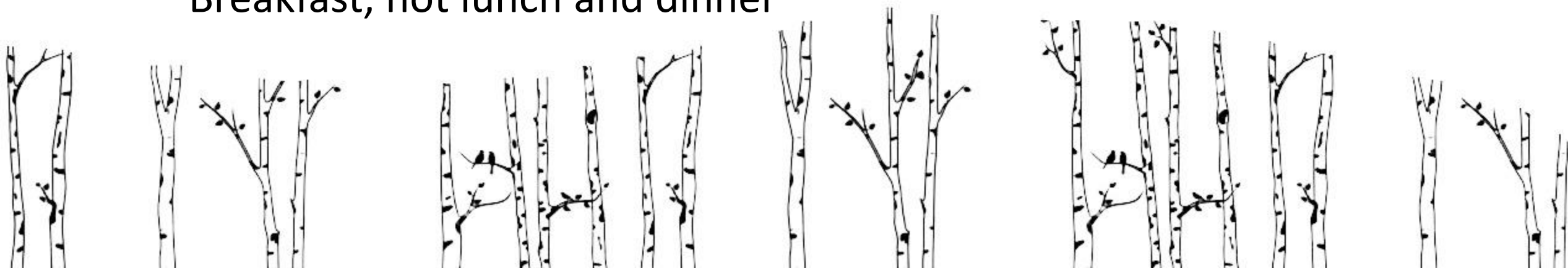


Scandic Syd
