
WARM-UP & QUARANTINE

- Warm-up/quarantine area is same as during previous competitions
- Quarantine entry deadline on 15 March is 14.00.
- There is single point of entry to the warm-up/quarantine area. Entry & exit are allowed through this point only!
- No telecommunication devices are allowed inside the warm-up / quarantine area from the moment of quarantine deadline!
- There are a warm hall and toilets available in quarantine area
- Competitors can leave their bag before start at a bag drop-off point in the hall and pick it up themselves after finish by using another entry door (see arena scheme below)
- During the quarantine time coaches can leave the quarantine area at any time, but they can not enter again before the end of the quarantine
- Quarantine ends when first male teams have started to last leg. It will be announced by speaker on the arena.

WARM-UP & QUARANTINE

- Quarantine area is considered extended for coaches. This extention inlcudes teams' zone on the arena. Traffic of coaches forth and back between warm-up and coaching areas is allowed, but should be kept as minimal as possible.
- Second leg competitors are allowed to enter the arena immediately after the leader of the race on first leg has passed spectators' control.
- Third leg competitors are allowed to enter the arena immediately after the leader of the race on second leg has passed spectators' control.

PROCEDURES

All pre-start procedures (clear-check-GPS-test) for all legs' competitors
occur in the warm-up area at the same place as all previous days. There are
additional test stations at the exit from warm-up area and at changeover
area.

FIRST STARTS

• Women's mass start at 14.00, men's mass start at 15.45

EQUIPMENT DEPOSITS

- There will be one equipment deposit (ED) in the terrain <u>for change of broken</u>
 <u>equipment</u>. ED is marked on the map with a sign "equipment deposit". ED is
 located approximately on half of the first loop of the course. First aid service is
 available at the same place.
- Equipment for transport to ED must be handed over to organisers in ski-test area next to the wax cabins at 13:30 at the latest.
- Equipment must be in closed ski bags and ski bags clearly marked with country abbreviation.
- Broken equipment can also be changed at coaching area, but no assistance is permitted during the change.

Map drop and map wall

- Womens's maps are located on left hand side of the track and men's maps on right hand side of the map! (NB! This is changed after team officials' meeting)
- Biggest number first and smallest number last.
- Previous loop maps should be dropped only in specified area before arriving to map wall.
- Always take the uppermost map.

After finish

 Finished competitors and those, who have abandoned the race, will be escorted by organisers to bag pick-up and then to after-finish-area. These arrangements are valid until the end of quarantine is announced during the men's third leg.

Prize-giving and closing ceremony

- Flower ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the finish of the best teams.
- Prize-giving and closing ceremonies will take place together with the dinner in the restaurant of the "Olimpiyskaya" hotel at 19.30!

Prize money

 Prize money for two last competition days to three best in ESOC will be paid on the arena immediately after the relay competition.
