

3. VENUES, ACCESS AND TRANSPORT

The Event will be located in Northern Italy. The Long and Middle distance races will be organised around Cansiglio Forest. The last competition, Sprint Relay, it will be held in Olympic town of Cortina d'Ampezzo (Province of Belluno), 90 km from the Event Centre.

Nearest major airports are Venice Airport (70 km, 45 min by car) and Treviso Airport (60 km, 45 min). Airports of Verona and Bologna are withing 2 hours' drive.



We recommend using own transport or a rented car. When using public transport, nearest train station is Conegliano (all major trains stop) and Vittorio Veneto. From Conegliano and Vittorio Veneto to the Event Centre it is possible to take a bus (line 129).

During the World Cup the organisers will only provide compulsory transport from the quarantine to Start and Arena.

4. EVENT CENTRE

The Event Centre will be located at [Banca Prealpi Convention Centre's Auditorium](#) in Tarzo, Province of Treviso. The exact location is 45° 58'43.9"N 12° 13'50.1"E.



5. ENTRY

5.1 ENTRIES AND ENTRY DEADLINES

- The deadline for Team Size Entry is 31 July 2021 (-2 months)
- The deadline for Team Names Entry is 19 September 2021 (-10 days)
- The deadline for Late Entries, Changes of Team Size or Team Names is 29th September 2021 at 12:00

Team Size Entry (deadline 31 July 2021)

The following information shall be filled in:

- Team manager (Chosen from list in IOF Eventor)
- Number of Team athletes (Men and Women)
- Number of Team officials
- Number of Team athletes in the individual races (Federation Team Quota will be

published by the IOF).

There is no maximum number of officials per team.

Team Names Entry (deadline 19 September 2021)

The following information shall be filled in:

- Name of each Team athlete by selecting from federation members in IOF Eventor

Competition Entries

Names of the competitors and, if required, their starting group, shall be entered in IOF Eventor, before 12 noon on the day before of each race.

Late Entries, Changes of Team Size or Team Names

Late Entries and changes will be accepted, if possible, up to 29th September 2021, 12:00. No late entries or changes will be accepted after that time.

Late entries and changes will always have a defined extra cost (surcharge). Late entries and changes will always be treated equally and must be communicated directly to the organiser.

After deadlines the Organiser will update the IOF Eventor with accepted changes.




7. EMBARGOED AREAS

The **marked competition areas** in Cansiglio Forest and in Cortina d'Ampezzo are embargoed areas. For competitors, team officials and others who, through knowledge of the terrain or the competitions, may influence the results of the competitions, it is prohibited to enter the embargoed areas.

These embargoed areas are valid until the day of the competition, except for Archetton map, which will be released in May 2021 and will be used for Italian Championships and afterwards for trainings. It is allowed to take part in the Italian Championships.

7.1 PREVIOUS ORIENTEERING MAPS

There are previous orienteering maps from Cansiglio Forest. They can be downloaded from the IOF Eventor or the Event website. No previous map of Cortina d'Ampezzo.

An official training camp is planned for 3rd–9th May 2021, with the following agenda:

For all competition: Valsalega Map is available for training from now on. After Italian Championship in May 2021 also Archetton maps will be available. Single printed map price is EUR 5, PDF-file costs EUR 50 and OCAD file is also available at price of EUR 150.

9. RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

9.1 COMPETITION RULES

The Competition Rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events 2021 and the World Cup 2021 Special Rules apply.

9.2 CLASSES AND PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS

There are two classes, Women and Men, for all individual races. For Sprint Relay competition there are no classes; and each team consists of 4 runners: two men and two women.

Participation restrictions, classes and qualification system will follow the Special Rules for the 2021 World Cup in Orienteering.

9.3 ANTI-DOPING

Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organisers of the World Cup are dedicated to supporting the Anti-Doping authorities in their work.

Doping controls may be carried out any time during the competitions in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of Testing and Investigations.

The IOF Anti-Doping rules and the World Anti-Doping Code 2021 apply as of 1st of January 2021. Athletes who are selected for doping control must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also bring along their therapeutic use exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, it is advisable that athletes bring along their ID to all competitions and events. 9.4 INSURANCE

The organisers decline any liability that might occur through participation in the IOF World Cup Events and trainings. Each person participates at her/his own risk and is responsible for her/his own insurance coverage (illness and accident).

9.5 COVID-19 MEASURES

Measures to avoid spread of the corona virus may be needed. If so, we will kindly ask participants and spectators to follow measures and possible restrictions. More information to come in coming bulletins, if needed.

9.6 CLIMATE

Average temperatures in Cansiglio at the beginning of October is between 10 and 20°C in daytime.

9.7 VISA PERMITS

The prerequisite for immigration into Italy is a valid passport. For travellers from certain countries a visa or further documents are required.

9.8 ATHLETE'S LICENCE

All athletes need to have an [IOF athlete's licence](#) to participate at the World Cup races.

11. COMPETITION INFORMATION

11.1 PUNCHING SYSTEM

The punching system used is SPORTident Air+. The competitor can use their own SIAC, providing the card number to the organizers via Eventor with the same deadline of the team's names. A second card will be provided by the organizer. Both cards shall be carried on the same arm. The punches from the two cards shall be merged to form the punching record (IOF Rule 20.7).

11.2 CLOTHING

It is forbidden to run with spike shoes. However, dobb spikes are allowed.

Otherwise, there are no regulations on clothing, but it is recommended to cover arms and legs in the forest race to avoid tick bites. Ticks might transmit Boreliosis and Meningo-Encephalitis.

12. EVENT INFORMATION

Vegetation The Cansiglio forest is formed mainly by pure beechwood, or mixed with white firs, the spruce, larch and birch trees are more sporadic

Format	Long distance, individual start
Map	Cansiglio, 1:15'000, 5m
Terrain	Orienteering terrain between 1000 and 1400m above sea level. Karst terrain with lots of point details; occasionally stony. A lot of charcoal platforms
Forms	Hilly topography with moderate to steeper slopes with a dense net of forest roads
Vegetation	Beech forest with high runnability and visibility

12.2 MIDDLE DISTANCE, 02 OCTOBER 2021

Format	Middle distance, individual start
Map	Cansiglio, 1:10'000, 5m
Terrain	Orienteering terrain between 1000 and 1200m above sea level. Karst terrain with many valleys and sinkholes, and lots of point details; occasionally stony. A lot of charcoal platforms
Forms	Hilly topography with moderate to steeper slopes
Vegetation	Beech forest with high runnability and visibility

Men	5,5km/200m climb, winning time 35'
Course setters:	Federico Venezian, Paride Grava

12.3 SPRINT RELAY, 03 OCTOBER 2021

Format	Sprint Relay, mass start
Map	Cortina d'Ampezzo, 1:4'000, 2.5m
Terrain	Typical mountain village with detailed historical centre and houses with private and public ownership. Meadows and Parks. Slightly pronounced difference in height.

Length	Leg 1 and 4: 3,5km/100m climb Leg 2 and 3: 4,0km/100m climb

13. PRIZE MONEY

A total prize fund of EUR 12'900 will be awarded from the IOF to the best men and women in the 2 individual competitions and best teams in Sprint relay.

14. PUBLIC RACES

Spectator races will be arranged on 30th September and 2nd and 3rd of October. Same area of the World Cup will be used for the Public Races.

Sunday 4th will also serve as Regional Middle Championship of Veneto, Trentino and Friuli Venezia Giulia. The race will be organised nearby Cortina d'Ampezzo.

Preliminary timing for the spectators' races is as follows:

Thursday, 30 th September	11.00 – 13.00
Saturday, 2 nd October	11.00 – 13.00
Sunday, 3 rd October	10.00 – 12.00

Various classes will be available for all-days participants, different Direct courses will be also provided for the ones who will enter on the day of the race.
