Welcome to Slovenj Gradec, Slovenia

Slovenj Gradec is the cultural and economic centre of the Mislinja valley in the northern part of Slovenia. With its number of inhabitants, it is a small town, but when you take its creative tradition and institutions into account, its importance extends over many borders.

Numerous exhibitions in the Carinthian Gallery of Fine Arts and events (some of them under the aegis of the UN) have brought the town closer to its foreign neighbours and that is how Slovenj Gradec got the distinguished title of the **Peace Messenger City** in 1989.

The historical image of Slovenj Gradec and its surrounding area stretches back to pre-historic times. This may be traced in the remains of Illyrian and Celtic settlement called Colatio. The medieval town was (like the other oldest Slovene towns) founded in the 13th century. It has survived centuries of turmoil but the town folk (most often artisans and merchants), together with foreign and native masters and artists, have managed to care for the image of the town. The old town centre has remained the focus of cultural and social life right up to the present day.

Slovenj Gradec has been a major event venue in Slovenia for mountain bike orienteering, which is an attractive and a dynamic sport, since 2005. Attractive terrains, accurate maps and nice climate have brought many different competitions to Slovenj Gradec since then.

We are going to do our best to make the WMMTBOC 2021 a memorable event.

Climate is mild at the time, the expected average temperature in May is 15 degrees. Can vary from year to year.

Competition rules

IOF MTB Orienteering Competition rules 2020

&

International specification for MTB Orienteering Maps 2010

GENERAL RULES

Event will take place in any weather conditions.

Competitors are responsible for their own safety, everybody starts at their own responsibility.

Use of cycling helmets is compulsory.

It is generally forbidden to leave the tracks. Exceptions will be shown on the map. Any violation will be punished with disqualification by controllers.

Bicycle must be with the competitor all the time. Competitor found moving without his/her bicycle will be disqualified. All controls are situated on paths.

It is forbidden to use some main roads (marked with red crosses on maps). **Competitors must follow traffic rules.**

Participants agree that results and photos taken on the event could be published, including via the internet.

COVID-19 SITUATION

At this moment status of event is not questionable and all preparations are going on according to the plan.

Organisers will evaluate Covid-19 epidemics situation regularly, next update about event status and possible travel restrictions will be issued in beginning of January 2021.
