

WELCOME TO VOLGOGRAD

The city was founded as the fortress of *Tsaritsyn* in 1589. By the nineteenth century, *Tsaritsyn* became an important Volga-river-port and commercial centre, leading to its population expanding rapidly. During the Russian Civil War, *Tsaritsyn* came under Soviet control. On April 10, 1925, the city was renamed *Stalingrad* in honor of Joseph Stalin. During World War II, the Axis forces attacked the city, leading to the Battle of Stalingrad, one of the largest and bloodiest battles in the history of warfare. On 10 November 1961, Nikita Khrushchev's administration changed the name of the city to *Volgograd*.

Known as the "Hero City", Volgograd today is the site of *The Motherland Calls*, an 85-meter high statue dedicated to the heroes of the battle, which is the tallest statue in Europe, as well as the tallest statue of a woman in the world. The city has many tourist attractions, such as museums, sandy beaches, and a self-propelled floating church. Volgograd was one of the host cities of the 2018 FIFA World Cup.

VENUES

Russian Orienteering Cup (WRE)/Orienteering Festival in honor of the 76th anniversary of the Great Victory will take place in living districts and memorial parks of Volgograd and Volzhsky, Russia. The distance to Moscow is 900 km. Volgograd Airport (VOG) is connected by direct flights with Moscow, St. Petersburg and other cities of Russia. Volgograd railway station is a 5-minute drive from the city centre. The current train schedule can be viewed on rzd.ru.

COMPETITION RULES, CLASSES AND ENTRY REGULATIONS

WRE

The Competition Rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events will be applied to participation in the WRE.

- There is one class for women and one class for men, there are no age restrictions. (Rule 5.7)
- All competitors represent a Federation (Rule 6.5)
- A competitor may represent only one Federation during any one calendar year (Rule 6.1)
- Competitors who are representing a Federation shall have full passport-holding citizenship of the country of that Federation (Rule 6.2)

Russian Orienteering Cup (non-WRE)

Russian Orienteering Festival in honor of the 76th anniversary of the Great Victory.

The Competition Rules according with Russian Orienteering Federation Rules will be applied.

- There is classes for women and men: WM10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 35, 45, 55, 65+, OPEN
- All competitions are individual
- The Winner of each class is determined every race.

ACCOMMODATION

Volgograd offers a wide range of accommodation from hostels and apartments to 4-stars hotels. Organizers recommend hotels with special offers for Russian Orienteering Cup and Festival participants:

Option A: Hotel "Tourist" (Event Center) 73 Marshal Chuikov st., Volgograd. 15-25 euro/day/person depending on the category of room, meals 3-times a day are included.

Option B: Hotel "Yuzhny" 18 Raboche-Krest'yanskaya st., Volgograd. 25-40 euro/day/person, depending on the category of room, breakfast included (buffet).

Option C: Hotel "Start" 4 Gramshi, Volgograd or Hotel "Tsaritsynskaya" 1G Barrikadnaya st., Volgograd. 7-10 euro/day/person in double/triple rooms.

Teams and athletes are free to choose their own accommodation, but some hotels and apartments are located within embargoed areas. Accommodation in them is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
