VENUE

The city of Kemi is the venue of the final World Cup round in 2021. The area is located by the Bothnian Bay in the Finnish Lapland with over 60 000 inhabitants. City of Kemi is easily accessible by air, rail and road. The Kemi-Tornio airport is only 10 minutes away from the city center. Luleå, Oulu and Rovaniemi airports are just under two hours away. Kemi railway station is situated along the Finnish main track and multiple trains run daily from Rovaniemi, Oulu and Helsinki.

COVID-19 REGULATIONS

The organizers take COVID-19 very seriously and therefore we are working closely with the local health authorities to ensure that all competitors and organizers remain healthy. We will create COVID-19 instructions that involve preventing the spread of COVID-19.

While arriving to Finland, be prepared to present a certificate of a negative Covid-19 test result that is at maximum 72 hours old. This is to be checked together with the travel documents. While flying within Finland, we recommend not to occupy seats next to each other (whenever possible) and to wear a disposable face mask

After arriving in Kemi all competitors and other team members must take required COVID-19 tests that organisers will provide to get the accreditation. Estimated cost of the test is 100 euros.

COVID-19 instructions will be published on the 22th of January at the latest at wsoc2022.com.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

According to the current regulations, citizens of some countries must obtain a visa in order to enter Finland. Please check the following website for more information:<u>https://um.fi/visa-to-visit-finland</u>

Visas should be applied at your nearest Finnish Embassy. Please note that conditions of entry to Finland can change and all participants are advised to keep up to date with the current situation by consulting their local Finnish Embassy.

Note that the model event of the World Cup 2021 will be held in the embargoed area of WSOC 2022.

ENTRIES AND FEES

Entries giving the number of athletes of each gender, the number of team officials and the team manager's name, address, e-mail address and phone number shall be done to IOF Eventor by January 25th 2021.

Each athlete's name and gender and the names of the team officials shall be done to IOF Eventor by March 8th 2021. Late entry fees and dates are according to the IOF's competition rules.

The entry fee is $60 \in$ per race per athlete. Entry fee includes model event, participation on the race, competition map and start and result lists.

The accreditation fee for team officials and athletes are $60 \in$. Accreditation fee includes team leader meetings, start and result lists and transportations between the Event Centre and the Arena.

TERRAIN, CLIMATE AND DAYLIGHT

The terrain in sprint is located by the sea next to the settlement. The competition area is a park, where visibility is good. A few roads pass through the competition area. Height differences are very moderate; the area is between 0 and 10 m above sea level. City of Kemi prepares a 1 km ski track in the park in winter time. There are also some open walking tracks in the park.

The terrain in pursuit and middle distance is covered with spruce and pine forests including some small swamps. Spruce forests are partly rather dense. There are clear cutting areas and forests which have been thinned. Around the competition area there is a ski track. One snowmobile track and one skiable road runs through the area. The area is between 10 and 30 m above sea level.
