



Sprint relay & Relay (WSOC) (JWSOC, EYSOC)

Roll call










- There is no pre-start quarantine! All team members can enjoy sprint relay competition on the arena.
- Sports hall is available for competitors for changing clothes, having rest etc
- Model event area can be used for warm-up
- Warm-up area next to the arena is shown on separate file
- There is after-finish-quarantine for finished 1. leg competitors in youth and junior classes. Therefore 1. leg competitors in these classes must have on the arena a bag with clothes ready for immediate pick-up after finishing and they must leave the arena for quarantine in a hall up on the hill. This occurs under supervision of the organisers.
- After-finish-quarantine expires when leading teams have changed over to third leg.
 Competitors in the quarantine will be informed about the end of quarantine by organisers after due command from SEA. Approximate duration of the quarantine is 1 hour.


Warm-up area






Arena









Mass start

- Exact location of the mass start depends on snow conditions on the arena and may differ from what was shown on previous slides.
- Start procedure is similar to long distance mass start

Tracks and courses



- Snow conditions similar to todays, probably a bit worse
- Snow-free spots on tracks occure, especially on dotted tracks
- Courses will be adjusted according to snow conditions, some snow-free areas will be left out of use. New maps with changed courses will be printed tonight.
- It is possible, that some manually made last-minute corrections are needed on the maps. In that case teams will be informed about such changes in the morning before the competition
- Tracks will be groomed during the night and morning
- Organizers try to improve snow conditions on the tracks as much as possible

"Black roads" on the map appear in one version—sanded or snowless road (covered with purple "v"-s on the map)





Map wall (all classes)

- Map wall on the arena can be seen by all competitors in the morning before the race.
 Please make sure, that competitors check out the set-up of maps on the map wall
- Team numbers are shown on the wall above the maps. Always take the uppermost map of the team
- Team and leg number are printed on the frontal side of the map

Equipment & Refreshments



- Equipment deposit is located at the coaching area on the arena as it was during the pursuit/long competition
- It is only allowed to change damaged ski equipment in this designated area, and no assistance (e.g. from a coach) is permitted during the change
- Only youth and junior classes pass the arena at the coaching area

Ceremonies



Prize-giving ceremony for middle distance and relays together with closing ceremony will be arranged on ski stadium at 15.00. Alternatively, if condition of the stadium is too poor, the ceremonies will be moved to the sports hall
