




Embargoed Areas from Juanary 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 till May 24, 2021

Below is an overview of the embargoed areas.

The areas marked 'Middle may 22", ''Mass Start may 24 and ''Sprint may 23" on the map are embargoed for all orienteering activities, unless specifically permitted by the organiser. The embargoed areas are out of bounds for all potential participants and team members, including competitors, team leaders, coaches, doctors, escorts, and any other person with a potential connection to a team (athletes or others). This means that all potential participants and team members are not allowed to visit these areas with or without a map at all, regardless of whether it is an orienteering activity or a training session.









### 7. ENTRIES \$ PARTICIPATION and CLASSES

Competitors participate at their own risk. Third party insurance and personal in jury insurance is mandatory and shall be the responsibility of their federation or themselves, according to national rules.

All foreign participants must have medical certificate dated less 1 year before may 20 2021 if they want to have ranking.


### Summary of the most important rules:

Riding off the track, trail or path is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. It is only allowed riding:

### in open areas (specification orange) or in fore



in forest (specification Black grid)



Competitors riding off road in restricted areas are responsible for any damage claimed by the landowners and will be disqualified.

- In France one drives on the RIGHT side of road.
- Therefore riders must ride on the RIGHT side on all roads andtracks.
- Overtaking slower riders should be done by the LEFT.
- You are not a priority. Respect other users : pedestrians, walkers .

### 14.TIME KEEPING SYSTEM

- The sportIdent system will be used on the 4 races. The range AIR+ will be specified in the next bulletin
- The use of SIAC chips and regular chips are permitted on all races.
- - 35 SI Card will be available for hire for € 10 for the 4 races. The reservation must be made at the same time as the registration.

### 15. ANTI DOPING

- Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organizers of World Ranking Event and National are dedicated to supporting the anti-doping authorities in theirwork.
- Doping controls may be carried out any time during the competition period..
- Doping tests are always carried out in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of testing. The IOF Anti-Doping Code and rules apply as of 1st January 2015.
- The participants who are selected for the doping tests must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The participants should also bring along their therapeutic use exemption (TUE) if applicable.
