DM Sprint and DM Sprint Relay June 5th – 6th, 2021 at Tekniske Universitet Denmark (DTU)

Søllerød Orienteering Club invites you to the Danish National Championships DM Sprint and DM Sprint Relay 2021 on the Campus of DTU in Lyngby. This area was considered for the World Masters Orienteering Championships in 2018 and offers sprint orienteering of very high class. The event begins with Sprint, Saturday June 5th and ends with Sprint Relay, on Sunday June 6th. DM Sprint is an IOF World Ranking Event for the Senior Elite Classes and 3rd round of the Danish Løberen League 2021 for the junior classes. There are open courses in all levels of difficulty both days; however, registration must be made in advance before the event.

We offer:

2 high intensity sprint events in one of Denmark's most challenging sprint areas. Newly drawn map (2020-2012) by Mikkel Kaae-Nielsen and Rune Østergaard. IOF World Ranking Event (WRE) and part of Trimtex Cup and Løberen League. Same venue both days.

IMPORTANT

DM Sprint and DM Sprint Relay are organized to be in compliance with the national corona regulations expected to be in effect at the time of the event. They allow outdoor sport events to be held in groups of 150 persons with a maximum of 3.000 persons in action at the same time.

The event is governed by both the common regulations of the Danish Orienteering Federation (DOF) known as "Reglement 2021" and the special corona regulations and guidelines issued by DOF on June 8, 2020. <u>Link to DOF corona regulations</u>.

Changes to the event execution may be necessary if either the national or DOF corona regulations are tightened before the event. This will be announced on the event's homepage and in Bulletin 2.

All participants in DM Sprint and DM Sprint Relay must be able to produce a valid corona passport or proof of a negative corona test result not older than 72 hours.

Competition Area

DTU Campus in Lyngby. The competition area is shown on the event's homepage and link below. Access closed for participants and their coaches according to DOF (Danish Orienteering Federation) Regulations 2021. Exceptions are travel by public roads through the area, though without use of a map of the area.

Notice: Travel in the area is not allowed on the day of the competition.

Parking and Meeting Point

At DTU Lyngby Campus, Anker Engelundsvej 301, Building 101A, 2800 Kgs. Lyngby. GPS 55.785471, 12.523067. Entrance to Parking and Meeting Point only allowed from Anker Engelundsvej from Lundtoftegårdsvej. Look for the white and orange control flag.

Any clubs arriving by bus are asked to give preliminary notice to the event's e-mail (see below).

Directions given by parking officials must be followed in all circumstances. Notice that the parking areas are public and traffic regulations must be followed. Cars must be parked in the marked spaces.

Participants in DM Sprint shall go directly from the parking area to the start or quarantine zone without passing the Event Center. At DM Sprint the Event Center Office is located at the parking area.

Participants in DM Sprint Relay shall go from the parking area to the Event Center where the start area is located. At DM Sprint Relay the Event Center office is located at the Event Center.

Event Center

DM Sprint and DM Sprint Relay have same event center on a grass area in the southern part of DTU Campus. At DM Sprint the participants are not allowed to enter the Event Center before their race.

All participants must leave the Event Center quickly after finishing their race.

Quarantine Zone

Participants in DM Sprint in classes H/D 18, H/D 20 and H/D 21 must go directly from the meeting point to the quarantine zone and are not allowed to be in the event area prior to start. This does not apply to DM Sprint Relay.


Map

DTU 1:4.000 and 1:3.000, Contour interval 2,5 m. Drawn 2020-2021 according to ISSprOM 2019 by Mikkel Kaae Nielsen and Rune Østergaard. Maps are approved by a map consultant and with a DOF quality mark.

The maps for DM Sprint are off-set printed on water- and tear- proof paper. The maps for DM Sprint Relay and Open courses are laser print.

Classes H/D 60 and older have maps scale 1:3.000. Additional classes have maps scale 1:4.000.

Terrain Description

Open Campus area, divided into squares with buildings of varying size as well as a residential area with separate buildings which are connected by paths. Many hedges, bushes and vegetation beds.

Moderate contours. Surface of grass, cobblestone and asphalt. Small areas of open forest. Several roads cross through the area. At the time of competition minimal traffic is expected. Parts of the area are under construction. These will be shown on the map.

Participants

Every member of a club under DOF (Danish Orienteering Federation) or IOF on the day of the competition is granted access to the competition classes.

Only runners who are members of a Danish club under the Danish Orienteering Federation and are 1) Danish citizens or 2) have a Danish cpr-number on the day of competition can receive prizes in this Danish Championship. All members of a relay team must fulfill these rules.

Prizes

No. 1 in D21 and H21 receive Danmarks Idræts-Forbunds Championship Medal. No. 2 and 3 in D21 and H21 receive DOF's Championship Medal in silver and bronze.

No. 1, 2 and 3 in the remaining championship classes receive DOF's Championship Medal in gold, silver and bronze.

Open Courses

Open Courses are offered both days in the same competition area as the championship courses. Registration in advance of the event is required in O-Service or by mail for international participants.

Participation in an Open Course is not allowed prior to participation in a championship course.

Punching system

The competition will use SportIdent. Controls have SI devices which support both traditional and touch-free cards.

Runners using their own SI-card must provide the SI-card number at the time of entry.

Entry without SI-card number will be provided a rental SI-card (touch free) at an additional fee of DKK 30. Rental SI-cards will be handed out at the start and must be returned at the finish.

Missing return of a rental card costs DKK 650.

Free start for participants on Open Courses 15:00 – 16:00

Joint start per class.

Free start for participants in Open Courses from 10:30 - 12:00.

Entry

Entry for DM Sprint and DM Sprint Relay through club administrator by O-service. Deadline Friday May 21, 2021. Late entry allowed until 96 hours before first start.

Entry for Open Courses in O-Service or by email for international participants. Deadline Friday May 28, 2021.

Entry for WRE classes W21/M21 MUST use IOF Eventor - DM Sprint. This includes both Danish and international participants.

Entries for all international participants except WRE-participants in DM Sprint through the events e-mail (see below) and payments made to the bank account named above.

Entry for DM Sprint Relay for international participants team-wise by sending an email (see below) and payment for the entire team by the account mentioned above.

Note: Every member of a relay team must write name, age, class, SI-card number, club and country as well as the order of start.

Team changes

A relay team's members names and start order can be changed by the club administrator through O-service or e-mail for international participants until Friday June 4 at 10:00. Following that, changes can be made until 8:00 on the day of the event by paying an extra fee of 50Dkr per team for each time a change is made.

Changes and late entrees can be made by sending an e-mail or delivering to the Event Center Office. The extra fee can be paid by MobilePay at the office on the day of the event.
