Czech Cup - sprint



===== covid measures =====

Selfreporting + incoming check: at entrance to the event centre will be collected [self-report form](#) (available also in ORIS) and measured temperature (must be bellow 37,5 C). Participants then get wrist-band for faster identification afterwards. After self-report takeover is possible to leave competition centre and go back to parking, etc.

RT-PCR test – all participants have to be tested by method RT-PCR latest 48 hod before competition day. Test result will be noticed in selfreport form and proof (sms, certificate, ...) has to be shown, but competitor keep this proof. Test in not required for those who have suffered a case of covid-19 in the past 90 days.

Respirators – all participants have to wear respirator all time except competition itself and during time for preparation (like running to the start)

Date 8. 5. 2021

Event centre: [Jihlava - amfiteátr](#) (N 49°23.947', E 15°35.602')

Registration: **not necessary to go to registration** (*if payment made in advance*), for needed cases will be available whole time starting 60 min before start

Distances: parking – event centre: 200 m - 300 m
centre – start: 1.900 m (elev. 50 m), marked with white-blue flags
centre – finish: 0 m

Parking: nearby center

Start: interval start, 00 = **16:45**

Terrain: historical centre of city, attached forest park, ZOO
Traffic will be neither limited nor regulated, but have low intensity (only residents are allowed to drive to centre, to go through main square only public transport is allowed)
Pay attention to pedestrians

Shoes restriction: no shoes with spikes, athletic shoes is recommended

Punching system: SportIdent – air mode with range 0,5 m, possible to use all versions SI cards
Clear and check stations in pre-start, finish unit is air-mode as well. In case of malfunction of control unit, mechanical backup punching to the map shall be used.

Control descriptions: printed on map and also in pre-start available (size 15 x 5 cm)

Courses parameters: (*length given for DH16-20 as direct line, for WM21 as shortest sensible route*)

Map: Jihlava 2021, surveyed spring 2021, cartographer Matěj Píro, scale 1:4.000, E 2,5 m, ISSprOM 2019, size A4, waterproof - pretex

Special map symbols:

- x banner, electrical box
- o round information place, phone booth
- o tree

Forbidden area: during competition is forbidden to enter areas defined as forbidden in IOF Rules. Map has priority over real situation = do not enter to areas which are forbidden by map even if they look as passable. There are such places in terrain, where is used symbol 520 (=area that shall be not entered), will be checked by organisers and some of them also marked by tape.

Mandatory routes: start – beginning of orientation
last control - finish

Start list: published [online in ORIS](#), will be on pre-start

Start bib: ready for self pick-up in event centre

GPS tracking: selected competitors in classes W21E, M21E, D20, H20, D18 and H18 will run with GPS units. List of competitors will be published on web in advance. GPS units will be handed out in pre-start area and collected in finish. Record available after last start.

Finish: Time limit: 30 min., finish closed: 19:20
Maps are collected until last start

WC: in event centre + 1 x Toi-Toi aprox 100 m before start

Protests: claims in written to national controller latest 15 min. after last finish, complaint then in written to IOF Advisor latest 15 min after decision about previous claim, no fee

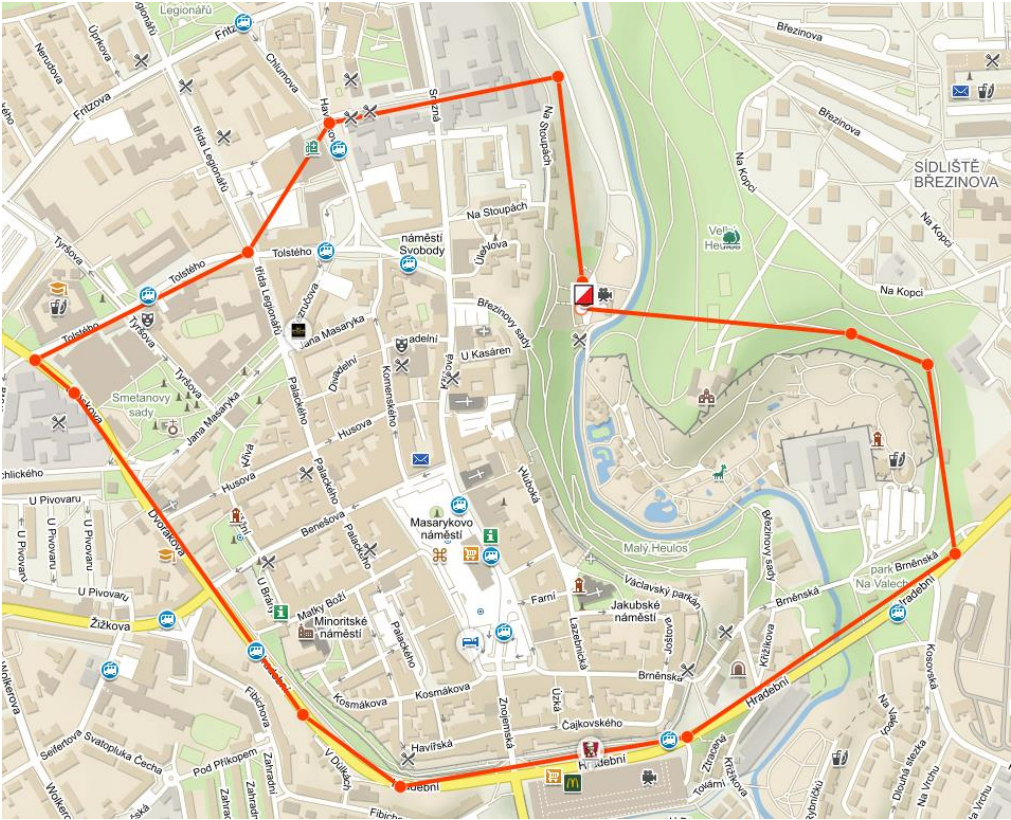
