

HOST CITY

Throughout history, Kocaeli has been a gateway connecting Europe with the Middle East and Asia. It was the capital of the ancient Kingdom of Bithynia and a crucial trade centre for the Eastern Roman Empire.

Today, along the commercially active Black Sea and the Marmara Sea shorelines, Kocaeli boasts 34 ports and industrial facility docks, making it a logistics heaven and a gateway to global markets. The province is a hub for both national and intercontinental routes. It is adjacent to Istanbul, one of the world's largest metropolitan centres and close to two international airports; Istanbul Sabiha Gökçen(SAW) and Istanbul Havalimanı (IST), 20 and 97 km. from the city centre respectively.



Kocaeli is home to more than 1,600,000 people and is one of Turkey's most densely populated cities. This is also the home port for the Turkish Navy, demonstrating the continuing historic and strategic importance of the province in military terms.

Gebze will be hosting town in Kocaeli.

Gebze is a district in <u>Kocaeli Province</u>, <u>Turkey</u>. It is situated 65 km (30 mi) southeast of <u>Istanbul</u>, on the <u>Gulf of Izmit</u>, the eastern arm of the <u>Sea of</u>

<u>Marmara</u>. Gebze is the second largest district in Kocaeli after <u>İzmit</u>, the provincial centrum in terms of population.




The district of Gebze is located in the westernmost portion of Kocaeli Province, with neighbors Tuzla to the west; Pendik, northwest; Sile, north; and Körfez, to the east. The district includes 6 municipalities (Gebze, Darıca, Çayırova, Dilovası, Şekerpınar, and Tavşancıl) and 22 villages (Ahatlı, Balçık, Cumaköy, Çerkeşli, Demirciler, Denizli, Duraklı, Elbizli, Eskihisar, Hatipler, Kadıllı, Kargalı, Köseler, Mollafenari, Muallimköy, Mudarlı, Ovacık, Pelitli, Tavşanlı, Tepecik, Tepemanayır (Tepepanayır), and Yağcılar).

EVENT CENTER

Event Center is Gebze Tecnical University (GTU). GTU has around 5.000 student during education period in Gebze. Distance from the Event Center to the city center Gebze is 4-5 km. The coordinates of Event Center is 40°48'50.6"N 29°21'38.2"E







Directions to the Event Centre

Gebze is easy to reach by car and rail being located 65 km south west of Istanbul connected by direct highway and railway. The nearest international airport is Sabiha Gokcen.



ACCREDITATION

All registered participants must check in for accreditation at the JWOC Event Centre before 11.00 on Saturday 04 September. Each registered team leader must be present and show all passports/valid ID cards. The personal JWOC ID cards with photo will be handed out at accreditation for all accrediated participants. All accredited persons must wear it at all relevant times, and present it for access to all means of transport and authorised zones.

The online entry form asks that all persons to be accreditated provide a personal portrait photo in Eventor for use on the ID card.

ANTI-DOPING


Doping is strictly forbidden and the organisers of JWOC 2021 are dedicated to supporting the anti- doping authorities in their work. Doping tests are always carried out in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard for Testing. The IOF Anti-Doping Code apply as of 1st January 2021.

Athletes who are selected for the doping tests must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area - the JWOC ID card is acceptable.

The athlete should also bring along their Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, it is advisable that the athletes bring along their ID to all the competitions and events. For more information, please consult https://orienteering.sport/iof/anti-doping/

TERRAIN INFORMATION



SPRINT

Terrain areas located 20-100 m above sea level in downtown of Kocaeli. Mainly city environment, in a hilly terrain with buildings, some parks, narrow streets and many stairs and steps. Mostly good runnability. Ground: 85% asphalt and 15% cobblestone with some stairs. Mostly residental area with many paths and roads. The visibility is generally good. Some streets are forbidden for motor traffic. There can be artificial features.



MIDDLE QUALIFICATION & FINAL

Terrain areas located 160-250 m above sea level. Hilly terrain with a lot of counter detail. The vegatation is generaly oak forest with, dense bushes and stony area. Also there are vegatation frequency transitions. There are dense thicket and stony grounds that make it difficult to run but generally runnabilty is normaly. Visibility is sometimes low, sometimes medium, sometimes quite good. The terrain has some depressions, erosion guly and controlled stream corossing. Earlier cut tree bough available from place to place. Rocky fields are the major features in some parts. The competition area has some paths and forest roads.



LONG & RELAY

Terrain areas located 270-325 m above sea level. Hilly terrain with a lot of counter detail. The vegatation is generaly oak forest with, some small open area, dense bushes . The terrain runnability is very good. Visibility is some part of the terrain is low but generally quite good. The forest mainly dry underfoot, generally covered with fern, open land areas mainly covered gras.

Developed network of paths and forest road. Stony and rocky areas are few.

FINISH AREAS

The coordinates of finish lines located in the arenas are shown below;

<u>Sprint</u>: 40°45'49.3"N 29°55'15.5"E, <u>Middle Qual and Final</u>: 41°00'19.7"N 29°33'42.2"E, Relay and Long: 40°55'22.1"N 29°32'56.2"E.

FIRST AID

First aid services will be provided in the arenas.

Event Office will also help with contacting the appropriate service.

Competitors participate at their own risk. Please be aware of Rule 6.4, each federation is responsible for its own insurance.

PUNCHING SYSTEM

SPORTident Air+ punching system will be used in all competitions. OC will give 2 SIAC cards to each competitor. It is not allowed to use private SIAC cards.

ARENA PRODUCTION

There will be TV coverage which will be shown on a big screen in the arenas.

This means that there will be cameras in the terrain, and many athletes will run with GPS.

COMPETITION CLOTHING

There are no special regulations applying to athletes concerning the type of clothing they choose to wear.

It is forbidden to use shoes with spikes in the Sprint competition and in Sprint training areas

TEAM OFFICIALS MEETINGS

For each competition, a "Team Officials Meeting" (TOM) will be held before the competition day, providing all important information about the competitions. There will be just one meeting for Middle distance, covering both qualification and the final.

All Team Officials Meetings will be held in the Event Centre. If you have questions for the meetings, please send them to info@jwoc2020.org before 16:00 on the respective day, and we will answer them during the meeting.

Only 1 representative from each country may participate to TOM personally since Covid restrictions.

The MOM of TOM will be published in few hours at the JWOC web site.

REST DAY ACTIVITIES

In connection with the Rest Day, taking into account the covid conditions, on Wednesday 08 September, open air social activities in the form of games, sport and challenges will be arranged at the Event Centre.

CODE OF ETHICS

Activities incompatible with the IOF Code of Ethics and the IOF Policy on Preventing Sexual Harassment may lead to sanctions towards individuals or the federations they represent, should these individuals be found responsible for the activities.

The acceptable level as to when a picture or a video may be seen as sexually expressive is unlikely to be the same for different individuals. A guiding principle will be to look at what clothing the athletes would use in e.g. a sprint competition. Any less clothing than this should not be expected to be considered acceptable. This both relates to posts in a JWOC-related social media or web page and in physical prints in the JWOC accommodation sites.

Team officials of all teams entered for JWOC 2021 are requested to discuss these principles with all athletes that will be entered for the JWOC 2021 competitions. This issue will also be addressed as an item on the agenda of the first Team Officials Meeting in connection with JWOC. TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

1st and 2nd offical training camps have been organized in Aug and Oct 2019 respectively. 3rd camp has been cancelled since current covid situation.

3rd camp has been postponed 2 times since Covid-19 outbreak.

OC has decided to organize a training camp btw 28 August – 01 September 2021 as pre JWOC activity. Detailed info about this camp will be announced in a specific Bulletin on 1 July via JWOC Web site/Iof Eventor.

TRANSPORT

Transport between Event center and opening ceremony (1 person from each country) will be provided and is covered by the accrediation fee. On the other hand, teams are strongly recommend organizing their own transport to minimize the Covid-19 risks.

Transport from/to the international airports will be provided on demand for extra fee shown below.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The sampling point required for Covid 19 testing will be located in these hotels. Those staying in these hotels do not need to go to the hospital. The OC will ensure that the test results are received and inform the participants of the results.

Please consider, full boards means without lunch. OC will provide lunch boxes on demand with 7.5 Euro each.


ENTRIES AND PAYMENT

All Entries must be made through IOF Eventor.

Each nation can enter a maximum of 6 women and 6 men, together with no more than 4 officials/coaches — maximum total 16.

All fees should be paid by bank transfer. Please note that the payer is responsible for all bank fees and charges both in their own country and in Turkey. Credit card payment is not available.

Entries will not be deemed valid until full payment is received by TOF.



For additions to the size of the team, accommodation bookings or transport between 04 July and 24 August, there will be a surcharge of 20% of the cost,

For cancellation of participants, accommodation bookings or transport between 04 July and 25 August, 80% of the amount paid will be refunded,

For additions to the size of the team, accommodation bookings or transport between 25 August and 04 September, there will be a surcharge of 50% of the cost,

For cancellation of participants, accommodation bookings or transport between 25 August and 04 September, 50% of the amount paid will be refunded,

Name changes made in the period 25 August to 04 September will cost 10€

COVID 19 INFO

OC takes COVID-19 very seriously and therefore we are working closely with IOF and the Turkish Health Board to ensure that all competitors, organizers and spectators remain healthy.

OC has prepared a Covid 19 Bulletin considering IOF and Turkish Health Board regulations. These regulations are valid as of Aug 3rd, 2021. If IOF and the Turkish Health Board make changes to the COVID-19 related rules including traveling, the organizer will make changes to the Covid protocol and inform competitors separately.

The main aim of the bulletin is to minimize the risks of a Covid19 infections and offer a safe event for both the participants and the organizers. All the published information is valid at the time of publishing. Any changes and updates to COVID19 recommendations and instructions will be shared when there will be new information available The Covid19 Bulletin is considered additional regulations as per IOF Competition Rules. This bulletin and the Covid-19 bulletin together give full information about the event. In case of conflicts between the two bulletins, the Covid-19 bulletin takes precedence overall.

All participants will be required in advance of the event to confirm that they have read, understood and will abide by the provisions in the Bulletin.

OC ask to consider the following important points.

- The form reachable at https://register.health.gov.tr/# must be filled in within the last 72 hours before travel by All competitors and support staff.
- Information on the website should be filled in order to provide you proper information and protect the health of yours and loved ones during the Covid-19 pandemic. A private HES code will be created automatically by the given information.
- The form you will fill may be checked at the borders of the Republic of Turkey whether you have filled in this form or not, and If you haven't filled in the form or made misleading statements, you may face legal and administrative sanctions. Furthermore, you might not be allowed to enter Turkey. (if you are not a Turkish Citizen or you do not have a residence permit).
- Upon arrival in Turkey, all competitors and support staff must perform a COVID-19 test using the PCR method within 24 hours and meet the requirements for self-isolation until the test result arrives);
- All competitors and other team members must take required COVID-19 tests at predetermined places of which the organisers will provide.
- The payment of the COVID-19 tests will be made either bank account transfer or in the Event office centre.
- Upon receipt of a negative test result, competition accreditation will be granted and persons may commence sports-related activities.
- The price of the COVID-19 test is currently approximately 55 euros, the cost of the test(s) shall be paid by the competitors themselves.
- OC recommend to have travel insurance which covers also COVID related medical treatment costs. The aim of this comprehensive testing is to create a 'bubble' whereby everyone involved in the competitions (organizers included) have been tested for COVID-19 and declared negative immediately prior to the event.

MEDIA

We welcome all media representatives who has a confirmation letter from member federations to JWOC 2020. Information can be received by contacting to info@jwoc2020.org.

In all arenas, work stations (tables and chairs) and internet connections as well as photo shooting areas in the terrain and the finish are provided to accrediated media stuff.

Accreditation deadline date is 1 September 2021. In order to be accredited, the conditions specified in the Covid 19 Bulletin must be met.

Accommodation and transportation etc should be booked by media representatives themselves. OC will provide lunch boxes to all registered media stuff.
