

Quarantine, pre-start & start

Quarantine: No Quarantine for relay competition.

Pre-start: on the Arena. All competitors are strongly advised to perform the SIAC battery test at the entrance to the Pre-start zone and in case of low battery indication request a SIAC replacement. There will be start lists and a clock showing the official competition time.

GPS units: GPS units will be handed out at the entrance to the Pre-start zone. These units should be returned immediately after the competition.15 teams in each class will get GPS units; the list will be published on website, IOF eventor & in event center.

1st leg start: 10 minutes before start athletes are called to perform SIAC clear and check. 5 minutes before the start, the athletes will be called up to the start area. The participants will start receiving their maps 3 minutes before the start but will not be allowed to take them before the start signal. A mass start for 2nd and 3rd leg runners of slower teams may take place if needed. The exact time will be announced well in advance by the arena speaker. Start will be given by speaker.

Start times: 10:00 – W16, 10:05 – M16, 10:10 – W18, 10:15 – M18, 10:20 – MIX














Arena & map turn-over

Arena passage: Arena passage is after 80 % of the course for all classes.

Coaching zone: There will be a coaching zone in the arena passage. Only two team official per team may enter this zone. Own refreshments may be given to the athletes.

Special information: Maps will be printed on both sides (Part 1 and Part 2). During the start (for all legs) you will get rolled map (Part 1 outside). During arena passage you need turn over your map.














Map turn-over











Start of the first leg

- 6 people in one start line. Start is in the finish corridor.
- Route to the start point is rough, be careful.
- Maps will be rolled with a white paper (with team number) covering the maps. You can remove the paper only after the start signal.
- First part of the course will be on the outside of the roll.
 - Arena speaker will make the countdown & announce the start.

Reserve maps will be attached on the other side of the map-wall










Change-over

Ex. Start / Finish Change over












Weather forecast in Vilnius













Questions & answers

Question 1: Can you please queue up teams for going back from arena after the relay. It was no order today in parking area close to arena.

Answer 1: Yes, we will do that. We encourage teams to respect your que.

Question 2: Is it a problem with today's results? no results found on Eventor nor EYOC website.

Answer 2: Results are uploaded to the IOF Eventor. You can find PDF file on the IOF Eventor site.

Question 3: Is it allowed to bring a map from today's long-distance competitions?

Answer 3: No. According to the rules, it is not allowed to bring any old maps of the competition area to the arena.









Questions & answers

Question 4: What about bus plan, how will it work?

Answer 4: Early buses are for first leg runners, following buses are devoted to the runners of the rest legs.

Question 5: Will GPS be used only for last leg runners or for all legs? **Answer 5:** GPS will be used for all legs. 15 teams according to the results of the last Championship will get GPS devices. For the first two legs, it will be visible only a white (blank) map.

Question 6: Is it possible to use your own transport? **Answer 6:** Yes, it is allowed. Please use the parking in the field on the <mark>right side before the Šilėnai village.</mark>









Questions & answers

Question 7: How mixed teams will be arranged?

Answer 7: Competition office received all entries which will be mixed later tonight on published in the start list.

Question 8: Are there control numbers on the map next to the control (1-31, 2-32, etc.)?

Answer 8: No, control numbers (codes) are only on description.

Question 9: How is the second start after map turnover marked – triangle or control?

Answer 9: Start after map turn-over is marked with triangle. Control numbers will continue further. Each side of the map is clearly marked: Part 1 and Part 2.
