COVID-19 health measures:

For the race to go ahead, we have to adapt our procedures to comply with current Ministry of Health directives.

Runners will need to present a "pass sanitaire" (health passport) in order to collect their race number for this competition and for the other events held during the week.

Only runners wearing their race number will be allowed into the race start area. Please observe shielding and social distancing measures. Face masks must be worn, except during the race.

Race registration ("Accueil"): masks must be worn, please reduce to a minimum the number of people visiting race registration. As far as possible, you should make payments and present any documents required in advance.

Snacks: there will be no food or drink providers present specifically for the event. Please use instead one of the many permanent bars and restaurants close to the race arena.

Drinks: we will not be providing water at the finish or during the race. Competitors should bring their own supply. The arena is in a busy commercial area of the city, with plenty of bars.

Results display: to avoid people grouping together we shall not be providing results screens. Live race results will be available via a local wifi network or via the internet.

Face masks: these must be worn at the race arenas, in the quarantine areas and up to the race starts. Competitors should bring enough masks to last the week. We are not able to provide face masks.

Runners' bags will be transferred from the quarantine to the finish by volunteers wearing masks and gloves.

Club tents: these are not allowed.

Electronic punching: the use of touch free sportident cards (SIAC) is strongly recommended.

The measures listed above may change as the pandemic situation evolves and health ministry directives are updated.

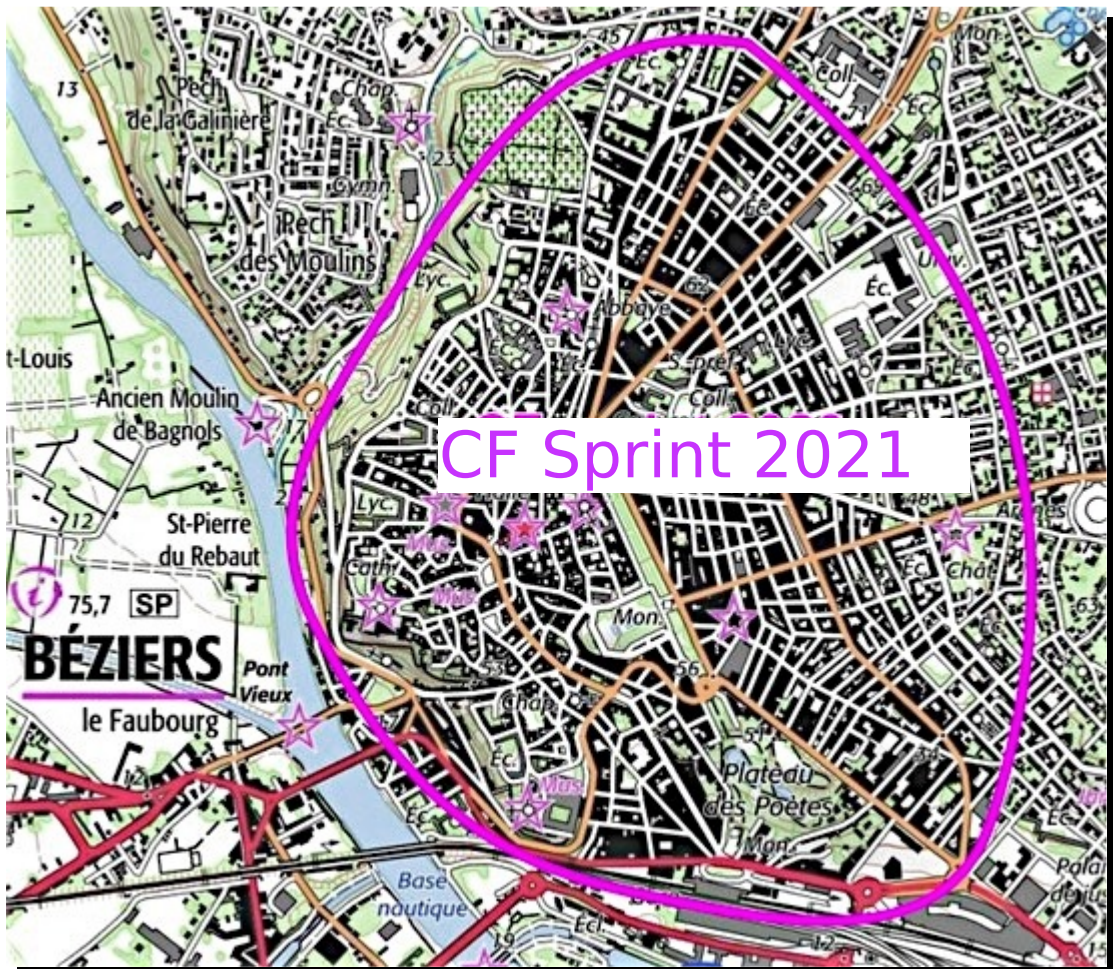

Cancellation and refunds:

- * Up to 12th October, entries can be changed or cancelled on the entries website
- * Up to 18th October, late entries will be accepted with a surcharge of 30%, and entries can be cancelled and refunded with a 30% deduction
- * After 18th October, it will not be possible to cancel or change your entry, even with a medical certificate. All entry fees become due on this date.

Qualification heats will take place in the morning, the final will be held in the afternoon.

We regret that constraints related to the televised broadcast of the event mean that we are unable to hold B or C finals for runners failing to qualify for the A final.
