3. PARTICIPANTS

Only the competitors who satisfy the following conditions may take part in a FISU World University Championship:

- Must be a national of the country they represent
- Must be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31st December of the year of the event; for 2022, athletes must be born between the 01/01/1997 and the 31/12/2004.
- Have to be students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognised by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
- Have to be former students of the institutions who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event

Each country may enter a maximum of twenty-one (21) persons: sixteen (16) competitors (with a maximum of eight (8) men and eight (8) women) and five (5) officials.

Maximum entries for individual disciplines :

Middle distance: - six (6) men and six (6) women Sprint distance: - six (6) men and six (6) women Pursuit distance: - six (6) men and six (6) women

Sprint relay: - two (2) teams of two (2) athletes (at least one (1) women per team)

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

5. REGISTRATION FEES

FISU shall receive from each competing country the following FISU registration fees:

- member-associations of FISU: 20 euros (€) per participant
- non-member associations: 40 euros (€) per participant

These fees will be invoiced to the participating delegations by FISU. Participation Fees to the Organizing Committee (accommodation, full board and event services):

- a participation fee of 70 euros (€) per person per night
- extra officials will pay a participation fee of 140 euros (€) per person per night



6. EMBARGOED AREAS - OVERVIEW


Embargoed areas are forbidden for all potential WUSOC 2022 athletes, team officials and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competitions. 7. EVENT CENTRE AND ATHLETES VILLAGE

During the FISU 2022 World University Ski Orienteering Championship all participants, will stay at **Hotel Astoria** *** in the city centre of Jáchymov. Room occupancy will be in accordance with FISU regulations.

WUSOC 2022 Event Centre will be located in Hotel Astoria.

7.1 CATHERING

Participation fee includes full board for one person per day. Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be served at the Hotel.

8. TRANSPORT

The official WUSOC airport is Vaclav Havel Airport Prague (PRG). Another arrival/departure point is Train Station in Ostrov (10 km from Jáchymov).

The Organising Committee will provide for all participants of the WUSOC free transportation to/from the Prague Airport and the hotel as well as connections between the competition venue, ceremonies and hotels by buses and minibuses.

8.1 TRAVEL PLAN

All the teams, participants and officials shall arrange their itineraries to arrive in Jáchymov or Prague Airport, and it also applies to departure.

If you travel by plane, please notify the Organizing Committee in advance, as to their arrival dates, times, and flight schedules, so that transportation arrangement can be made both to and from the Prague Airport.

We are kindly asking teams which are planned arrived by their own cars/minibuses to inform us as soon as possible.



9. PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS

Competition Rules

The 2021/22 edition of the competition rules for IOF Ski Orienteering events will be applicable to the 2022 FISU World University Championship Ski Orienteering.

Antidoping

The organisers will apply the IOF Anti-Doping Rules valid at the time of the WUSOC 2022.

Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organisers of the WUSOC 2022 are dedicated to support the anti-doping authorities in their work. Doping controls may be carried out any time during the competition period in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of testing.

<u>Insurance</u>

Competitors participate at their own risk. Insurance against accidents is the responsibility of their federation or themselves, according to national regulations. There are no other peculiarities of the event.

Visa

According to the current regulations citizens of some countries must obtain a visa in order to enter the Czech Republic. Please note that conditions of entry to the Czech Republic can change and all WUSOC participants are advised to keep up to date of the current situation.
