VENUE

The city of Kemi is the venue of the final World Cup round in 2021. The area is located by the Bothnian Bay in the Finnish Lapland with over 60 000 inhabitants. City of Kemi is easily accessible by air, rail and road. The Kemi-Tornio airport is only 10 minutes away from the city center. Luleå, Oulu and Rovaniemi airports are just under two hours away. Kemi railway station is situated along the Finnish main track and multiple trains run daily from Rovaniemi, Oulu and Helsinki.

COVID-19 REGULATIONS

Because of the current COVID-19 situation there will be following changes:

- Prize giving and opening ceremonies will be held outdoors at the arena straight after competitions
- Team official's meetings will be held only virtually in Microsoft Teams
- Only team official's are allowed to enter competition office
- No public transport from event center to arena or model event
- Not any kind of indoor available at the arena (no showers, dressing rooms in tents)
- Quarantine times restricted as much as possible during the races (more specific instruction in bulletin 4)

For accreditation to WSOC, JWSOC and EYSOC athletes and team official's must show and sign the following document: IOF Ban on fluorinated products for ski-waxing Declaration of Conformity.

TERRAIN, CLIMATE AND DAYLIGHT

In Kallinkangas there is also a small ski resort beside the cross country center. Kallinkangas is a very popular outdoor area. Part of the area is a very dense cross-country skiing track network. Altitude of the terrain is between 10 and 65 m above sea level. South part of the hill area the front rises gently and the north part is steeper.

Competition area consists of one wide hill, of two marshlands and an agricultural area. Part of the agricultural area is aforrested in places. Marshlands are partly open and partly dense birch and /or spruce forests. The cover of the wide hill is very rocky. The visibility is very good because there grows stunted pine forests.

FLUOR BAN

We remind all teams about the fluor ban and the declaration all teams have to sign:

The two current regulations (EC) No. 1907/2006 ("REACH") and (EU) 2019/1021 ("POP regulation") state that it is forbidden to produce, sell and use products (ski-waxes) containing PFOA (also termed C8 products). This applies to all such products, including those produced prior to 4 July 2020. The IOF declares that the use of such products is forbidden at IOF events, including World Ranking Events. For purpose of clarification this means that all PFOA/C8 products are banned while C6 products are still allowed for the season 2021/2022.

The IOF reserves the right for spot checks of products used, and to analyse such products in a licensed laboratory. For this purpose, I grant and guarantee access to waxing facilities (cabin/service van or other) and skis prior to and during the event upon the request of an IOF appointed person (Inspector).

In case of violations the IOF will impose sanctions including the disqualification and loss of event accreditation for the entire national team involved in the violation. Infractions may also lead to a referral to the IOF Ethics Panel for additional sanctioning. Organizator plan to have tests.
