These races start the Swedish MTBO-Summer which continues with races in Uppland 22nd and 23rd July, finishing at O-Ringen in Uppsala 25th – 30th July.



Races 16th and 19th July have World Masters Series status, 15th and 20th July Swedish have Veteran Cup status, and 17th and 19th July Young Guns World Series status.
