

Hilly terrain with steep slopes, several stony areas and settlements ruins. Runnability ranges from clear open forest to dense vegetation areas. Marshy areas on the hilltop, with artificial water drains, mountain pine vegetation. Terrain and map examples shown below.

All classes will use the SportIdent electronic punching system. SI units including the finish unit will be set to Air mode (SIAC), allowing punching within a distance of 0.5m from the unit.
