Registration / Event office

In the event centre, Saturday 9:00 - 12:00. Registration will be for all club's competitors at once.

Information on issuing control descriptions:

Control descriptions will be issued at the start in the second corridor. Control descriptions will be printed on waterproof paper. The descriptions are printed on the map.

GPS tracking devices will be issued in the area before the start.

The dimensions of the control descriptions: W21E 55x130mm, M21E 55x180mm

Distances between the basic places of an event:

accommodation - parking 6 - 12 km
parking - centre up to 400 - 1500 m (from the bus about 1 km)
centre - finish 0 m (in the centre)

centre – start **2,1 km** total climb 105 m, about 30 minutes of free walking
The road to the start will be marked from the centre with blue and white ribbons.

Restrictions on the use of GPS

Reminder that IOF Competition Rule 21.4 allows the use of GPS devices if:

1. they have no map display
2. they have no communication capability other than receiving GPS data
3. they are not used for navigation purposes.

Terrain:

The space offers a varied natural mix of Ore Mountains. The area was mapped in the autumn of 2019 (in sun, snow and fog). The map is therefore more than 2 years old, but the revision took place in the spring of 2022 just before the race.

Map:

Scale 1:10 000, e=5m. Map size 35 x 24 cm. Maps are created according to a valid map key ISOM 2017-2, mapping date 2019, revision May 2022. Printed on waterproof material. Printed by Žaket using offset printing.

Forbidden areas

All areas mapped using the symbol *709 inaccessible area* on the map are forbidden. Furthermore, the Ocean reservation area. Not marked on the map (for clarity) or terrain. This is the only most significant and largest green area on the map (mark no. 410). An attempt to overcome it will be punished by a very significant loss of time, and only if someone manages to overcome the area at all.

Racing area

All the forest north of the road Lužec - Oldřichov - see the map at the end.

Method of marking mandatory sections

sections to the map start - red and white ribbons / tape

section between control and target - red and white ribbons / tape

Information about refreshments on the track:

There is one refreshment point on each WRE course on the way between the controls.

Start 00:

Saturday 21. 5. **13:00**

Interval start. Passage time through the start corridor is 3 minutes.

Punching

SportIdent Air+ (SIAC), finish punching device is in contactless Air+ mode

In the event centre next to the information board there is a Battery check box to check the capacity of the chip's batteries.

Erasing and checking the SI units in the dedicated space at the start.

SI-Reading immediately after the finish in the centre area.

In case of a non-functional punching at control, it is necessary to use mechanical punching anywhere on the map with pliers.

Returning of race maps

Maps are returning on both days in the reserved area after the finish. They will be available in the centre, in the finish area on the Sunday after the start of the last competitor.

Competitors running with GPS units provided by the organizer agree that they will record their route during the race, and this route will be published.

During the event, photographs will be taken to inform the public about the race. Also photographs can be taken for personal needs of competitors (such as race mementos, promotion of orienteering clubs), in particular during the prize giving ceremony and on the run-in to the finish. If you do not agree to be photographed, please let the photographer know explicitly.

General regulations:

The event takes place in accordance with the IOF rules, CSOS rules for orienteering and CSOS regulations for competitions in orienteering 2022.
