

3.2 Directions for obtaining entry permits (visas)

If you come from the EU or Schengen area country, you do not need a visa. Other international travelers may be required to hold a Bulgarian visa prior to travel to Bulgaria, depending on their country of residence. For visa information, please visit the government's travel website at https://www.mfa.bg/en/services-travel/consular-services/travel-bulgaria/visa-bulgaria. If you need visa help or special documentation, such as an "Invitation Letter", please send an email to teamcontact@variant5.org no later than 31.05.2022. Please make sure that you allow for sufficient time (at least 3 months) for invitation letters and visa processing. Also note that visa regulations are subject to change. Please double-check your specific visa requirements.

8 CLASSES AND PARTICIPATION

World Cup round

- There is one class for women (called Women) and one for men (called Men). There are no age restrictions.
- All competitors must be citizens of the country of the federation they are representing.
- All competitors represent a federation. Each federation may enter up to 6 women and 6 men
 for all individual competitions plus the current World Champions for the distance. Additionally,
 each federation may enter up to a further 2 women and 2 men, who qualify for the Women
 U23 and Men U23 classes respectively, in each individual competition.
- In the Mixed Relay each federation may enter a maximum of 4 teams of 3 riders. Each team must include at least 1 woman.
- Each federation may enter a maximum of 10 team officials.
- Each competitor must have a valid IOF Athlete Licence.

WMMTBOC (Masters)

- The following classes are offered: W35, M35, W40, M40, W45, M45, W50, M50, W55, M55, W60, M60, W65, M65, W70, M70, W75, M75, W80, M80, W85 and M85.
- Two adjacent classes in the same decade will be merged if either or both have fewer than 5 entries. For example, if there are fewer than 5 entries in the W50 and/or W55 classes, the two classes will be merged to make a single W50 class. The classes W70, M70, W75, M75, W80, M80, W85 and M85 will always be offered in five-year age groups, regardless of the number of entries.
- Participation is open to all competitors according to their age classes. A participant may choose to enter for a younger age class but not older. There is no limit to the number of participants from one federation.

U23 World Championships

- There is one class for women (Women U23) and one for men (Men U23). Women and men belong to the U23 classes up to the end of the calendar year in which they have their 23rd birthday.
- Every federation may enter up to 2 Women U23 and 2 Men U23 for each of the two individual competitions. Only competitors who are entitled to compete in the U23 classes may be entered.
- The additional U23 competitors are entered for the classes Women or Men. The entry procedure is the same as for Women and Men.
- All competitors entered in Women or Men who are aged 23 or younger will automatically also be ranked in Women U23 or Men U23.

• In 2022 the titles of Women U23 World Champion and Men U23 World Champion are awarded in Sprint and Long distance.

8.1 EXTRA INFORMATION

On 15th of September team officials and elite athletes who are complying with the age regulations can participate in the WMMTBOC Mass start or in the open classes of the MTBO Tour.

On 18th of September elite athletes who are not riding the Mixed Relay can participate in the WMMTBOC Middle distance if they comply with the age regulations or in the open classes of the MTBO Tour. Those who ride the Mixed Relay can only participate in MTBO Tour as not classified.

On 16th and 17th of September (Sprint and Long distance) team officials who participate in the WMMTBOC will not be allowed to meet any World Cup participants (Finish Quarantines apply). Team officials can however take part in the MTBO Tour on these days instead of WMMTBOC in order to be with their World Cup team.

9 ENTRY

9.1 Entry procedure for MTB Orienteering World Cup 3 (incl. U23)

- Entries for the MTB Orienteering World Cup, round 3 and the U23 World MTBO Championships are made in **IOF Eventor**.
- Link to the event in IOF Eventor: https://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/6805
- Participants can only be entered by their federations.

9.2 Entry deadlines (World Cup)

Team size deadline = 31st July 2022.

Entries must be submitted no later than 31st July 2022 and with the following information:

- total number of competitors of each gender
- number of competitors in each competition
- number of relay teams
- number of team officials
- team manager's name, email address and phone number

Team names deadline = 4th September 2022.

No later than 4th September 2022 the following information must be submitted:

- each competitor's name, year of birth, gender resp. class, and the competition in which he/she will compete
- each competitor's number of the electronic punching card (if competitors have a SIAC and want to use their own card)
- names of all team officials

Late entries and name changes

Late entries and changes will be accepted by the organiser if possible but an additional fee will be charged \rightarrow 10.2.

After **10th September**, no entries will be accepted.

- Late payments will be subject to an additional fee of 10 % of the total amount.

For WMMTBOC (Masters):

- Full payment of all entry and accreditation fees (and possible other fees, e.g. rental fee for punching card) must be made:
 - **REGULAR entries**: no later than **31**st **August**.
- Late payments will be subject to an additional fee of 10 % of the total amount;
- The Early Bird discount was only valid for full payments made up to 31st May.

10.4 Cancellation of the event

If the event has to be cancelled after **31st July**, the organiser will retain 15 € per participant (competitor or team official) in order to cover committed costs.

10.5 Withdrawals

For World Cup & U23 Championships participants:

- Refund of 80 % for withdrawals after the team size deadline (from 1/8 until 4/9 2022);
- Refund of 50 % for withdrawals after the team names deadline (from 5/9 until 14/9 2022).

For WMMTBOC (Masters):

- Refund of 80 % (of the reduced entry fee) for withdrawals after the early bird deadline until up to the regular deadline (from 1/6 until 31/8 2022);
- Refund of 50 % for withdrawals after the regular deadline until 5th September (from 1/9 until 5/9 2022).
- No refund for withdrawals after 5th September 2022.

12 COMPETITION RULES

12.1 Information about rules

The MTB Orienteering World cup, round 3, the World Masters MTB Orienteering championships and the U23 World MTB Orienteering Championships will be organised in accordance with the following rules valid at the time of the event:

- IOF MTBO Competition Rules
- for World Cup events (incl. U23): Special Rules MTBO World Cup

All the rules can be found at https://orienteering.sport/mtbo/competition-rules.

Further general MTBO rules:

- Competitors must get to all control points with their bikes.
- The bicycle must be with the competitor at all times.
- Wearing a rigid safety helmet is compulsory during competitions and training sessions.
- It is forbidden to use roads or tracks marked with purple crosses or a purple zigzag line on the map.
- Riding outside the mapped area is not allowed.
- In Bulgaria one drives on the right side of the road. Competitors must therefore ride on the right side on all roads and tracks.
- National traffic rules must be followed.

Non-compliant competitors or competitors who break any rule may be disqualified.

12.2 Info about off-track riding

Generally allowed

Riding off the track, trail or path is generally allowed, but it is forbidden in cultivated land such as orchards, vineyards and similar. These will be shown as out of bounds on the map (symbol 709). Off-track riding speed may vary a lot and is on own responsibility.

12.3 Controls not situated on paths

On some courses there may be off-track controls in rideable open areas. They will be set so as not to require control descriptions.

12.4 Anti-Doping

Doping is strictly forbidden and the organisers of the 3rd round of the CX80 MTB Orienteering World Cup are dedicated to supporting the anti-doping authorities in their work. Doping tests are always carried out in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard for Testing. The IOF Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code apply. Athletes who are selected for the doping tests must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also bring along their therapeutic use exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, it is advisable that the athletes bring along their ID to all the competitions and events.

12.5 Starting order

World Cup – according to the IOF MTBO Rules

For an interval start the starting order must be drawn in up to four start groups. Competitors ranked 1–15 in the IOF World Ranking list as published 10 days before the event are placed in group 4, competitors ranked 16-30 are placed in group 3, competitors ranked 31-45 are placed in group 2. All other competitors are placed in group 1. For every athlete ranked 1-45 that is not entered for the competition, the size of the specific start group is reduced by one. Within every

group the starting order is drawn at random. Start group 1 starts first, followed by start group 2, 3 and at the end start group 4.

For an interval start, competitors from the same Federation must not start consecutively. If they are drawn to start consecutively, the next competitor drawn must be inserted between them. If this happens at the end of the draw or at the end of a starting group, the competitor before them must be inserted between them.

The start groups are made according to the World Ranking Lists as published 10 days before the Event. This is the World Ranking of 5th of September 2022.

In relays, the order of competitors in the start rows (and their start numbers) is determined by the results of the last relay of the same type in the previous event of the same level. Where more than one team per nation is allowed to start, the order is first determined by order of teams within the same nation, then by the order of nations. (e.g. CZE-1, FRA-1, FIN-1, etc, CZE-2, FRA-2, etc.). Those not being placed in the last respective event are given the subsequent start numbers in alphabetical order of Federation abbreviation.

WMMTBOC

The starting orders are drawn at random without starting groups.

13 COMPETITION INFORMATION

13.1 Punching system

SPORTident Air+ (system for contactless punching with SI Active Cards SIAC) with a working range of 150 – 180 cm will be used. Competitors may use their own SIAC. Rental SIACs will be available at € 3 per day – deposit € 80.

IMPORTANT: All competitors have to check up their SIAC battery age on the following link: https://www.sportident.com/siacservice/. All SIACs with battery older than 3 years have to be replaced with "fresh" ones. We strongly recommend hiring SIACs for these cases.

There will be a battery check SI-station at the technical model event. It is strongly recommended to check your SIAC there as well. If it is not OK then you must use another SIAC for the following races.

13.3 Bike maintenance

Climate

September is the driest month in the region of Targovishte with 34mm (1.3in) of precipitation. The average minimum and maximum temperatures in September vary between 12 and 26 $^{\circ}$ Celsius. So the chances are quite good that the weather will be ideal for mountainbike riding during the event.

Hazards

Wild animals like deer, wild boars etc. might be present in the forests of the competition areas.
