

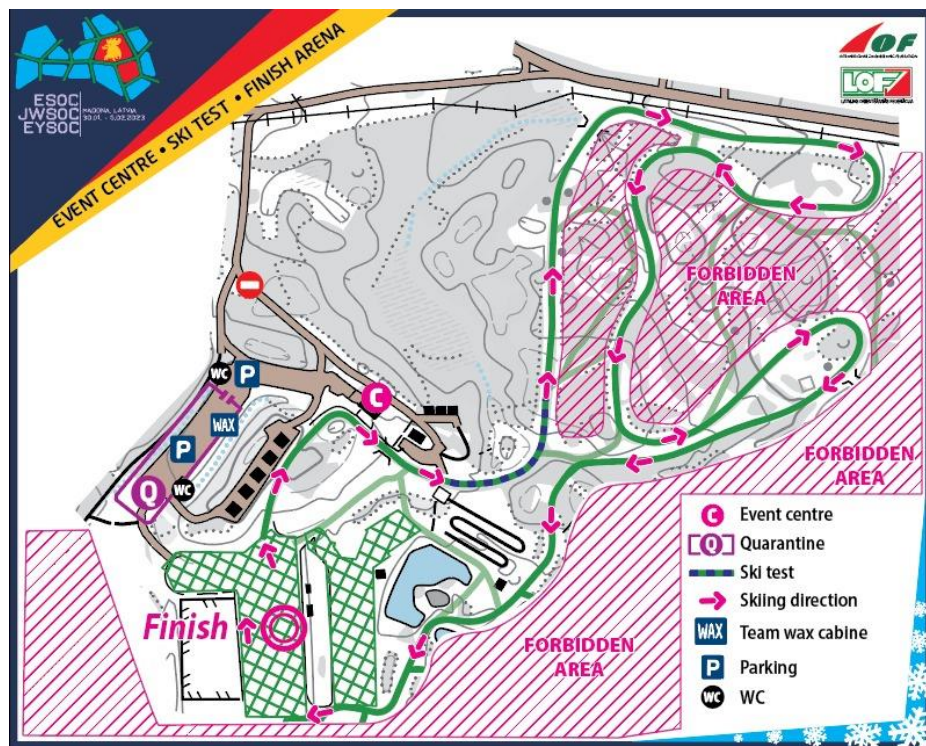



It is allowed to use the major ski track and open area in Smeceres Sils for skiing till January 29 (including), please see borders of embargoed area in *Picture 2* below. Due to safety reasons skiing on ski tracks is allowed only in direction indicated by arrows (see in *Picture 2*).

On competition days it is allowed to use the major ski track and open area in Smeceres Sils for skiing from 15:00 to 19:00 (See *Picture 2*), on January 30 and February 2 - from 9:00 to 19:00. Observe the skiing direction!



	<p><i>Picture 2</i></p> <p>It is allowed for ESOC/JWSOC/EYSOC team officials and other related persons, as well as athletes if they are not taking part in the Relay competition, to participate in the 4th February Public race. Public race on February 5 is open for all.</p>
