Venue

The event centre will be located at the skiresort Beitostølen, 210 km from Oslo Airport Gardermoen. Competition Centre will be at Beitostølen Cross country stadium.

Classes and participation

World Cup

There is one class for Women and one for Men. There are no age restrictions. The classes are called Women and Men.

U-23 World Cup and World Championship

There are Women U23 and Men U23 classes in the individual World Cup. Women and Men belong to the Women U23 and Men U23 classes respectively up to the end of the calendar year in which they have their 23rd birthday. They compete simultaneously in the Women's and Men's classes and are treated in all respects as competitors in those classes except that their results and scores are also listed separately in Women U23 and Men U23 lists. The Middle Distance and the Sprint are selected as World Championships for Women U23 and Men U23 Competitors. The titles of Women U23 World Champion and Men U23 World Champion are awarded in those two competitions.

Each Federation may enter up to 6 men and 6 women in each competition in World Cup. In addition, each Federation may enter up 2 women and 2 men, who qualify for the Women U23 and Men U23 classes. In addition, the organizing federation may have a national group, up to 10 men and 10 women. These runners are not counting in the World cup, and they are starting in start group 0 when there is interval start

In the World cup all athletes need an Athlete License. "All participants need a valid IOF Athlete licence. To have a valid licence, the athlete needs to sign an athlete licence form and pay an annual fee of 30 EURO. If the athlete has signed the form in previous years, they don't need to sign a new form. Payments of the annual licence fee is done in IOF Eventor, please consult the proper IOF Eventor Guide for this.

Team Officials Meeting

Team Officials Meeting for World Cup will be at the arena at 18.00, on Thursday 9th, Friday 10th and Saturday 11th of February.

Entry and Entry fee World cup

Preliminary entry

Entries giving the number of competitors of each gender, the number of team officials and the team managers name, address, e-mail address shall be given in **IOF Eventor: eventor.orienteering.org**, no later than **December 1**st **2022**

Entry fee

Accreditation fee Competitors and team officials: **600 NOK** Entry fee Competitors individual races: **600 NOK/race Entries are not valid until a full payment is received**

Final entry

Team names deadline. Each competitor's name and gender and the names of the team officials must be given in **IOF Eventor** by the *Team names deadline*, which is **January 31**st, **2023**(changed from bulletin 2). Changes may be made to the team until 12.00 on the day before the first race of the event. After that time, no further changes to the team are allowed under any circumstances (Rule 9.7)

Competition entry deadline. Names of the competitors that will take part in the next competition, must reach the organizer by the *competition entry deadline* which is 15.00 on the day before the competition (Rule 9.8).

Entry and Entry fee World Masters

Entry Entries shall be given in IOF Eventor: eventor.orienteering.org Entry fee WMSOC for each race 600 NOK for entries given in IOF Eventor before January 8th, 2023 750 NOK for entries given in IOF Eventor between January 9th and January 31st, 2023 1000 NOK for entries given in IOF Eventor between February 1st and February 8th, 2023 Payment in Eventor is mandatory, and entries are not valid until a full payment is received

Entry Open Competitions, Ski-O-treff

Entries for the open competition "Ski-o-treff" shall be given in **Norwegian Eventor: eventor.orientering.no.** All information about "Ski-o-treff" will be given in **eventor.orientering.no.**

For <u>WMSOC</u> payment in IOF Eventor is mandatory.

Participation in WMSOC requires that the entry fee is paid in advance. Your entry is only approved when full payment has been received and registered by the organizer. Payment is done in Eventor by the service PayPal. When you have finished your registration in Eventor, you click "SAVE" and continue to payment. You are transferred to the PayPal site and get a summary of you registration. On the PayPal site you can log on to your Paypal account, or you can choose to pay with Credit Card if you don't have an Paypal account.

For the Open Competition"Ski-O-treff" entry fee shall be paid in the Competition Office. For Norwegian Clubs the fee will be billed after the competitions.

For the World Cup and WMSOC at Beitostølen the organizers are cooperating with "**Beitostølen Resort**". Transport

To/from Beitostølen:

Beitostølen can be reached by car or buss.

NOR-WAY Buss Express, www.nor-way.no has a direct route from Oslo Airport Gardermoen to Beitostølen.

There will be a departure from the airport on Wednesday February 8th at 17.05, arriving Beitostølen at 20.45. On February 12th a bus will go from Beitostølen at 16.00, arriving the airport at 19.40. Booking is possible right up to departure, but to be guaranteed a seat, it is recommended to do so a few weeks in advance.

Book bus ticket at www.nor-way.no Price 670 NOK (one way). Tickets for February 2023 will be available to book from December 2022.

For groups that want to rent their own bus we recommend contacting the bus company JVB, www.jvb.no For the sake of the environment, we recommend using public transport.

At Beitostølen: There are walking/skiing distance between accommodation, competition center, training tracks, restaurants, and shops. 1,5 km om foot/ski from Radisson Blu Mountain Resort to the Cross Country Arena

Terrain and climate

Mixed Forest with open marshes. Moderately hilly. Altitude 780-880m The climate is normally wintry with weather ranging from sunny to cloudy and snowfall. Average temperature for Beitostølen in February is -5--20°C. Average snow depth is 50-100 cm.


Punching system

Emit touch free punching system will be used.

All competitors in **World cup** will be equipped with EmiTags from the organizer. Private EmiTags will not be allowed in World cup.

In **WMSOC** and **Ski-o-treff** private EmiTags can be used. When registering in Eventor you can fill in the number of your personal EmiTag. If you leave this open, you will be assigned a rental EmiTag by the organizer. The fee for rent-ing EmiTag is 50 NOK pr day

Training possibilities

Beitostølen has more than 300 kilometres of prepared cross-country tracks, all reachable from your hotel or cottage. The tracks are in forest and open mountain areas. At **skisporet.no** or in the app **"Skisporet"** you can see the status of all tracks

Waxing facilities

At the competition center at **Beitostølen Ski Arena** the teams can rent Waxing Cabins, Waxing Cabin 12m². 2500NOK Waxing Cabin 15m². 3000NOK Waxing Cabin 30m². 4000NOK **The cost is for the period Wednesday - Sunday**

Clubs or groups of masters can also rent Waxing Cabin. One representative for the group makes the booking of Waxing cabin in connection with their personal entry for the event.

Waxing cabins has to be ordered in IOF Eventor together with entry.

World Cup National teams will be given priority when allocating the Waxing Cabins. The 30 m² cabins can be reserved for National teams only.

Indoor waxing in apartments and cottages is not allowed

Ban of fluorinated products for ski-waxing

Rule 21.8 in the Competition Rules for IOF Ski Orienteering events declares that the use of all fluorinated waxing products is forbidden at IOF events, including World Ranking Events. This also applies for participant in WMSOC and Ski-o-treff.

At an IOF Ski Orienteering event, each athlete, team official and supplier of ski waxing services must sign and submit the IOF Declaration of Conformity (Appendix 12) before the competition starts

Anti-Doping

"Doping is strictly forbidden Doping tests are always carried out in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard for Testing. The IOF Anti-Doping Code and rules and the World Anti-Doping Code 2015 apply as of 1st January 2015. Athletes who are selected for the doping tests must bring an official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also bring along their therapeutic use exemption (TUE) if applicable.
