Classes

Individual long distance competition: W14, W16, W18, W20, W21 M14, M16, M18, M20, M21 Relay: W16, W20, W21

There is a World Ranking Event (WRE) in the classes MW21 27.05.2023 on the long distance.

Long WRE course winning time

80 - 84 minutes for women (W21)

88 – 92 minutes for men (M21)



Participation

M16, M20, M21

Each competitor shall have full citizenship of the country that he or she represents. Each federation may enter a team of up to 56 competitors – up to 28 women and 28 men – and up to 5 officials of the team. The maximum number of members in each class is determined as follows:

The individual distance in classes W21E and M21E is an World Ranking Event (WRE) and the entry to those classes is open for every elite competitors. Citizens of RUS and BLR are not allowed to participate in BOC2023.

It is allowed to have in the team up to 6 individual runners altogether in groups MW16, 18, 20 but not more than 2 individual runners in one group. Individual runners in youth and junior groups can participate in relay but they do not compete for BOC medals and do not hold the team score points. Non-team runners should be entered on a national team entry form, and they should be separately marked as non-team runners.

Costs

Team entry fee is 1300 EUR (full team 46-56 runners), 1000 EUR (less than 45 runners). The entry fee includes:

- Participation in the competitions and the model event
- •Start and result lists (3 copies per federation)
- Free parking at the competition arenas

GPS

There is GPS tracking in classes M21 and N21. Runners with GPS will be marked in the start protocol and the devices will be distributed at the pre-start.




